This is what your screen will look like!



Add Pictures

1. Click on a picture you wish to add to your podcast. Drag it to the Podcast Track. (It says "Drag Artwork Here")



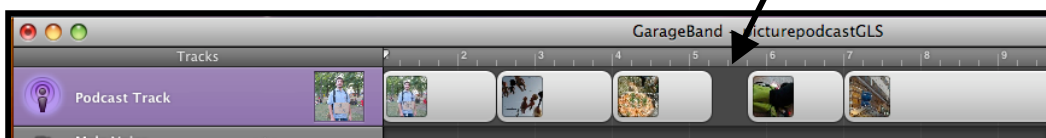
2. The picture will appear in the Podcast Track. If you want multiple pictures, drag them up to the same area, in the order you wish to have them appear in your podcast.

This is a Podcast Track with multiple pictures. All of the pictures should be touching. (See the above sample)

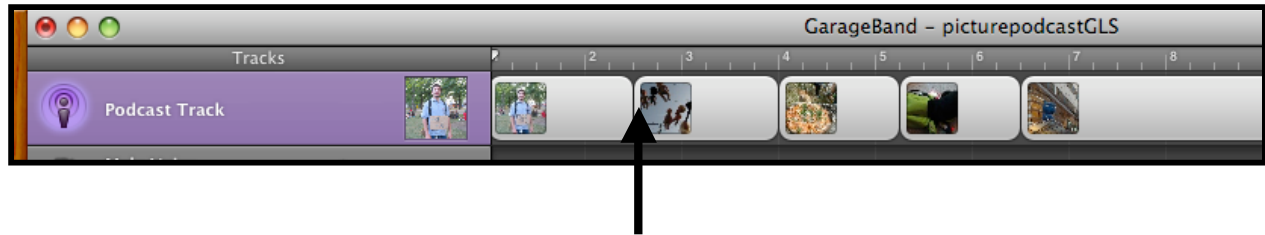
Do not leave space between pictures like seen below!



Adjusting your Pictures

You may wish to do this after you record your voice.

Adjust the length of time the picture shows

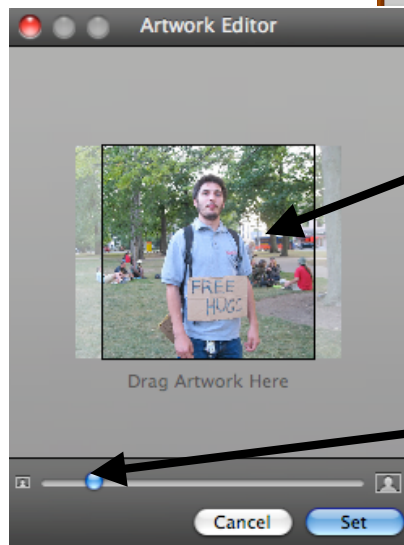


Put your mouse on the line at the end of the picture you wish to adjust. Click and drag the the line to the right to make it show for longer, or to the left to make it show for a shorter time. (You may need to adjust the pictures after you record your voice. This can be done at any time.)

Adjust the image displayed

Double click on the picture you wish to adjust in the artwork column.

This window will open



The image in the black square is the image that appears in the podcast. You can click in the center of the square and move the picture around to place it as you wish.

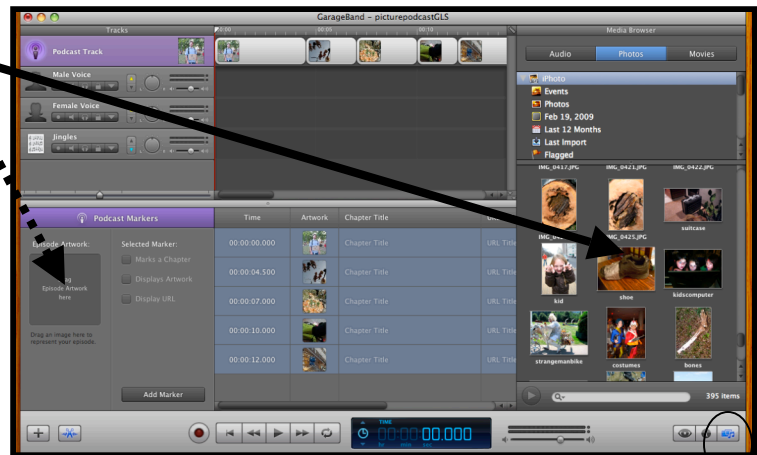
You can also zoom in our out by dragging the slider at the bottom.

When finished click "Set"

Chapters, and Links

You may wish to do this after you record your voice.

Click and drag a picture from the media browser to the box that says "Drag Episode Artwork Here". This picture will be displayed to represent this episode.



Click on this button to hide the media browser. (To view it again you can click it again). This will give you a little more room to work.

Recording Your Voice

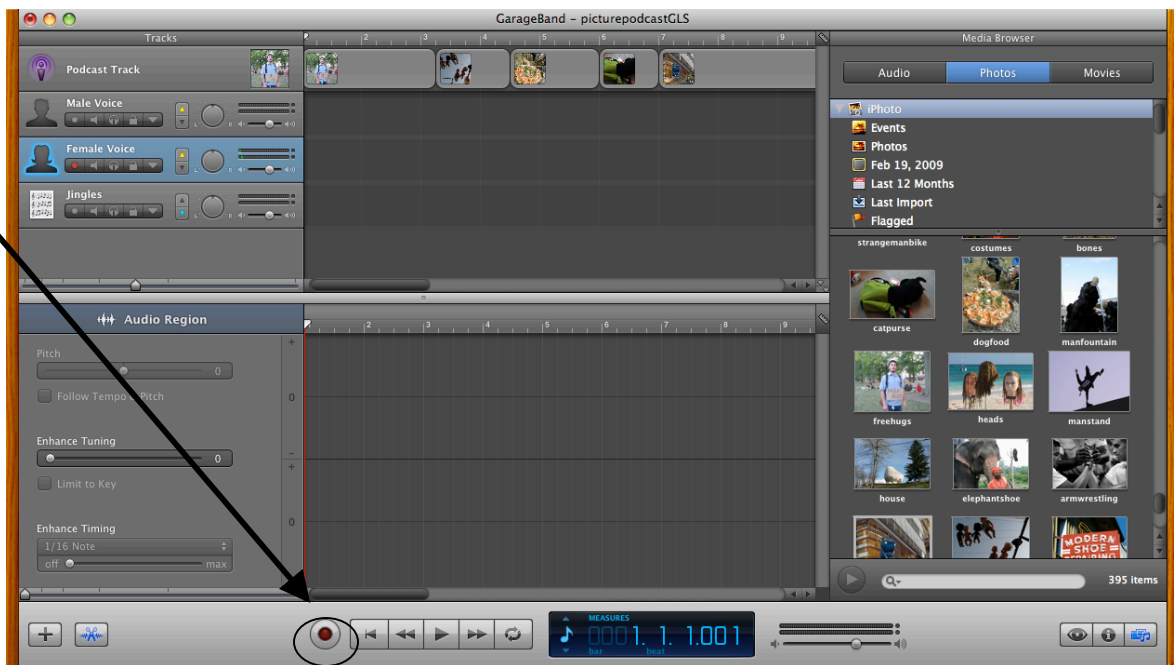
1.



Click on the button with the circle on it next to the male if you are a male, or next to the female if you are a female. This enables the track for recording.

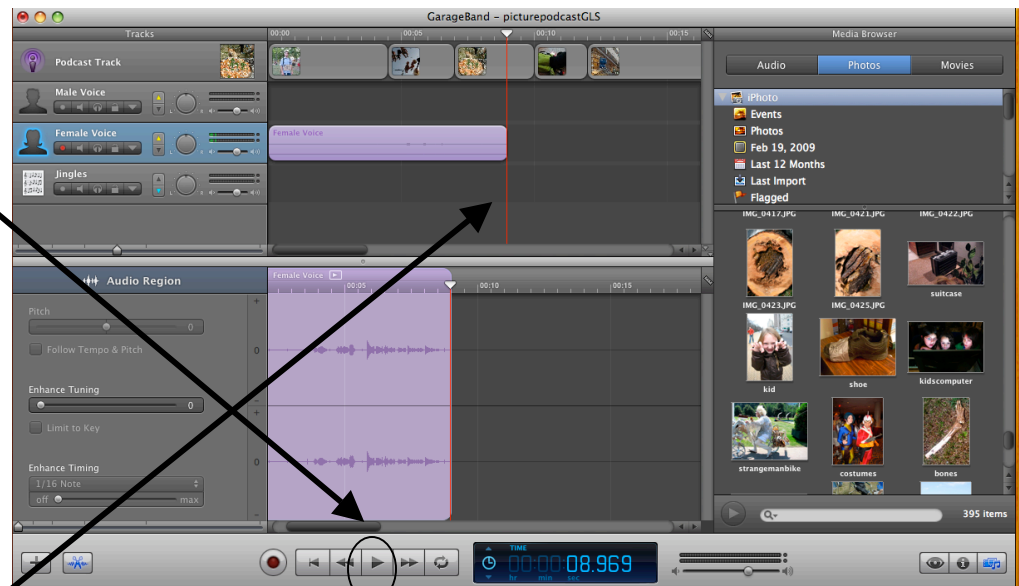
Now click this record button here to start recording.



3. Recording Your Voice (continued)

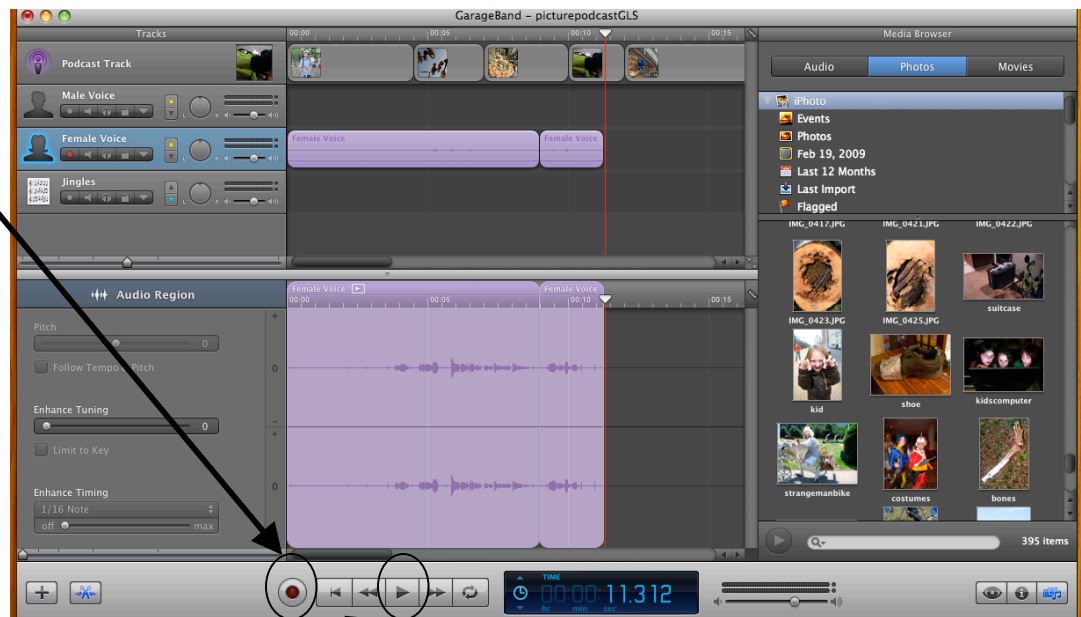
When you are done speaking, press the play button to pause the recording.

This red line is a bit like a cursor in word processing. It shows you where you are!



4.

If you need to record more, just press the record button again. Keep doing steps 2 and 3 until you have finished recording all of the voice you have to record.



Listening to your Recording

1.

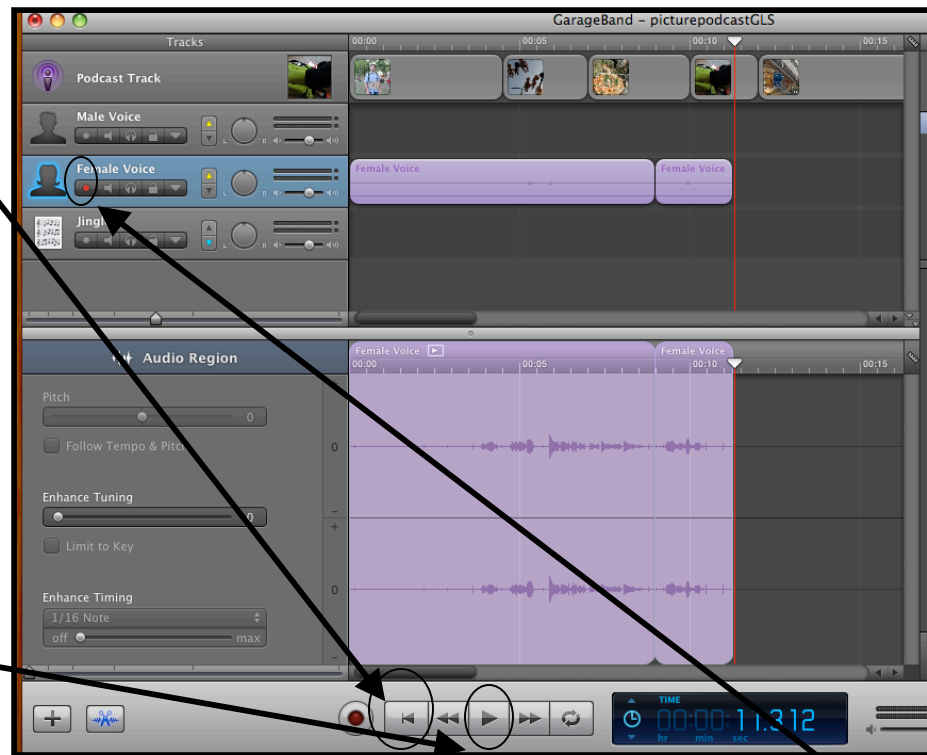
Click on this button to go back to the beginning of your recording.

2.

Click on the play button to listen to your recording. You should listen to your recording to determine where you need to edit.

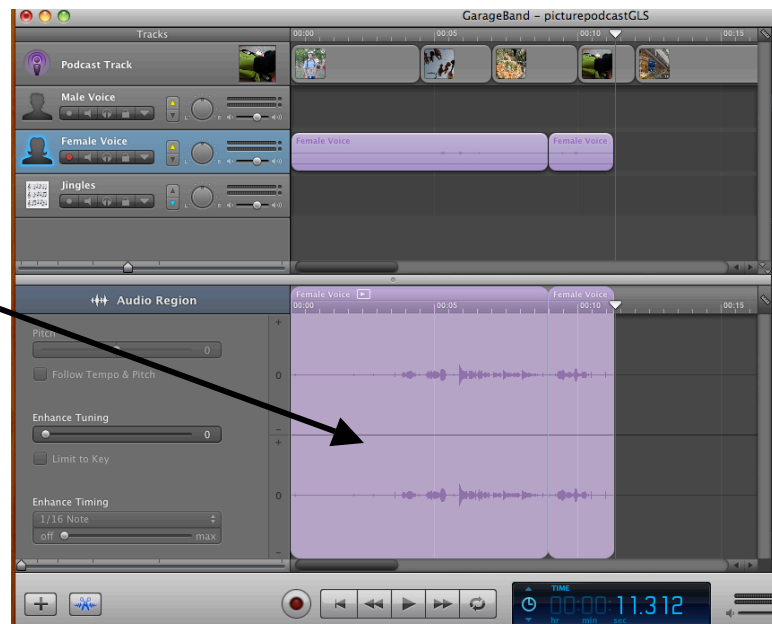

When you are finished recording, click on the button with the circle on it to disable recording on this track.



Editing Your Recording

If you need to edit your voice... You will edit down in the track editor. It allows you to see your tracks at a more "zoomed in" view.



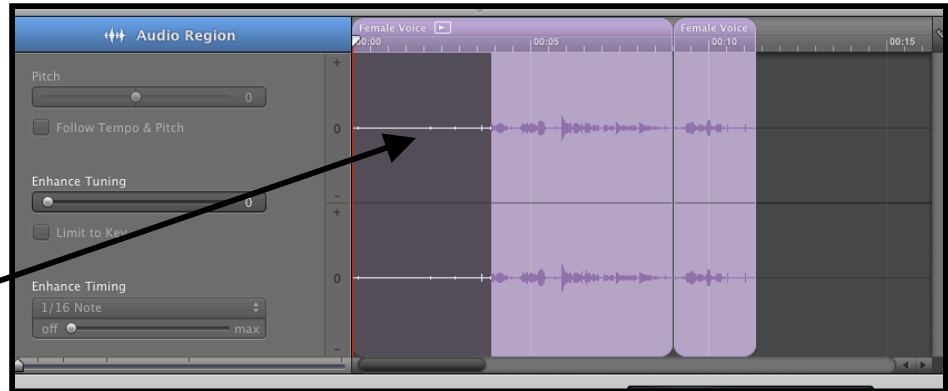
Editing (continued)

Delete Part of the Recording

1.

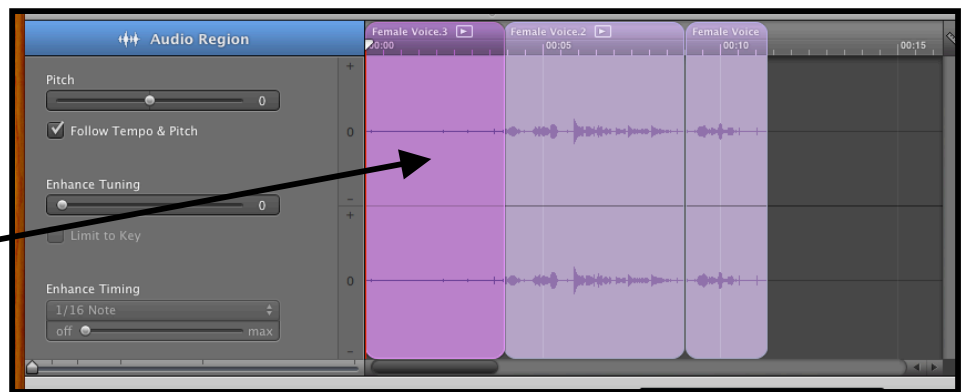
(Your mouse should look like a plus sign.)

Click and highlight the portion of the track that you want to delete. (It will appear dark grey)



2.

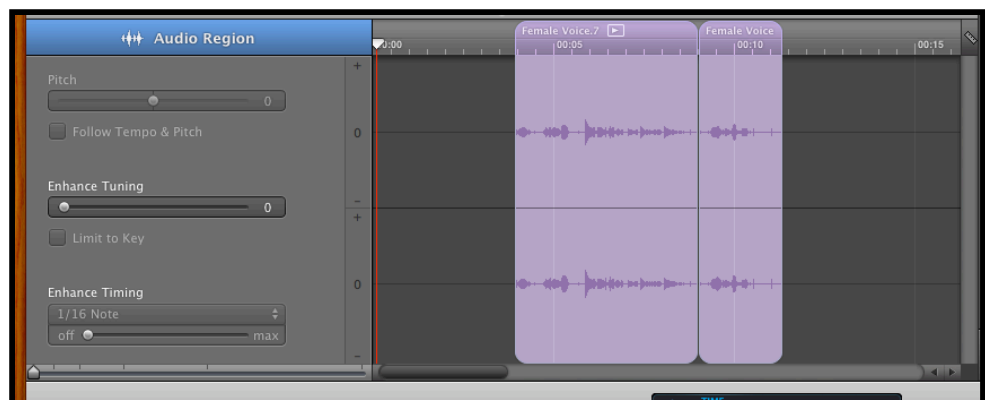
Click with your mouse on the portion you just highlighted to select it.

Press the delete key on your keyboard.

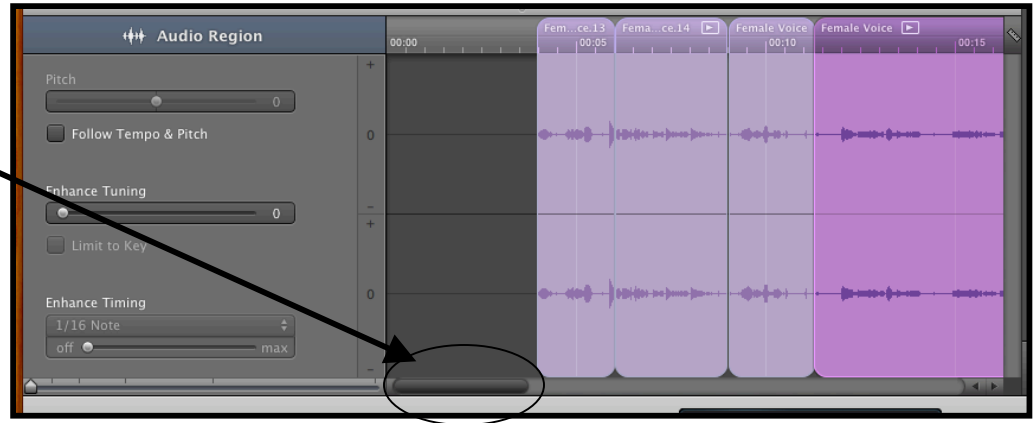
*You will know that you did it correctly if the section you wanted to delete disappears.



Editing (continued) Delete Part of the Recording

4.

Use the dark grey slider to get to the next section you want to delete.

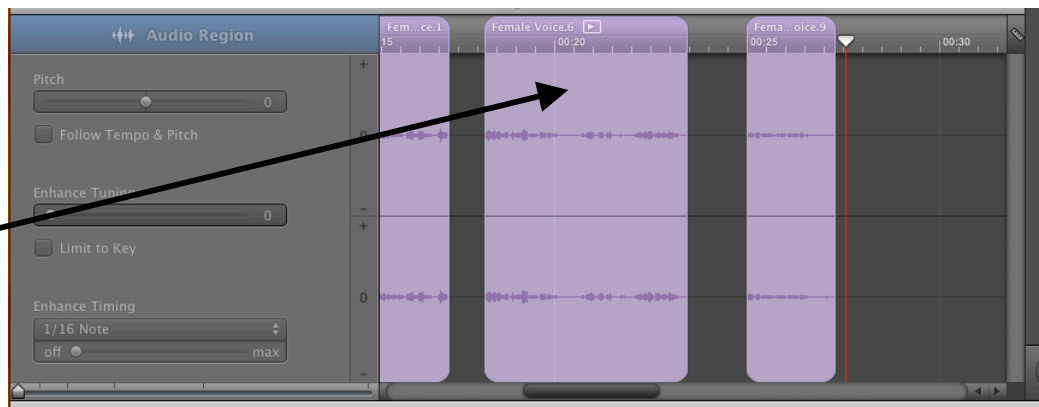


Once you are finished deleting unwanted recorded sound, You are ready to move the tracks together so that you do not have dead zones in your recording.

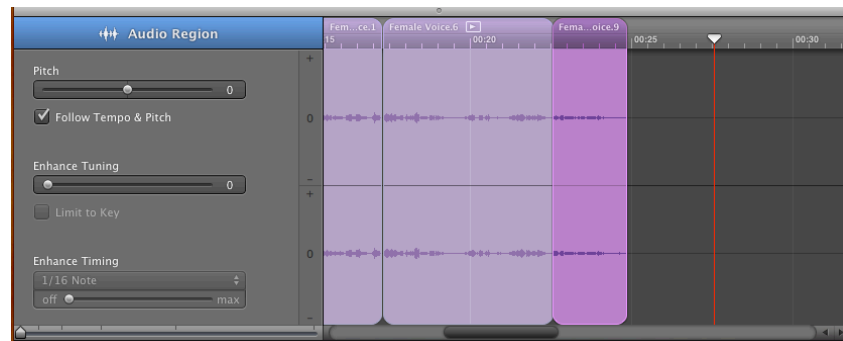
Delete Empty Spaces Between Recording

5.

Put your mouse above the vertical lines that represent your voice. (Your mouse will look like a vertical line with two arrows on either side.)



Click on the section you want to move, and drag it to where you want it to be. Be careful not to put it on top of another recording!

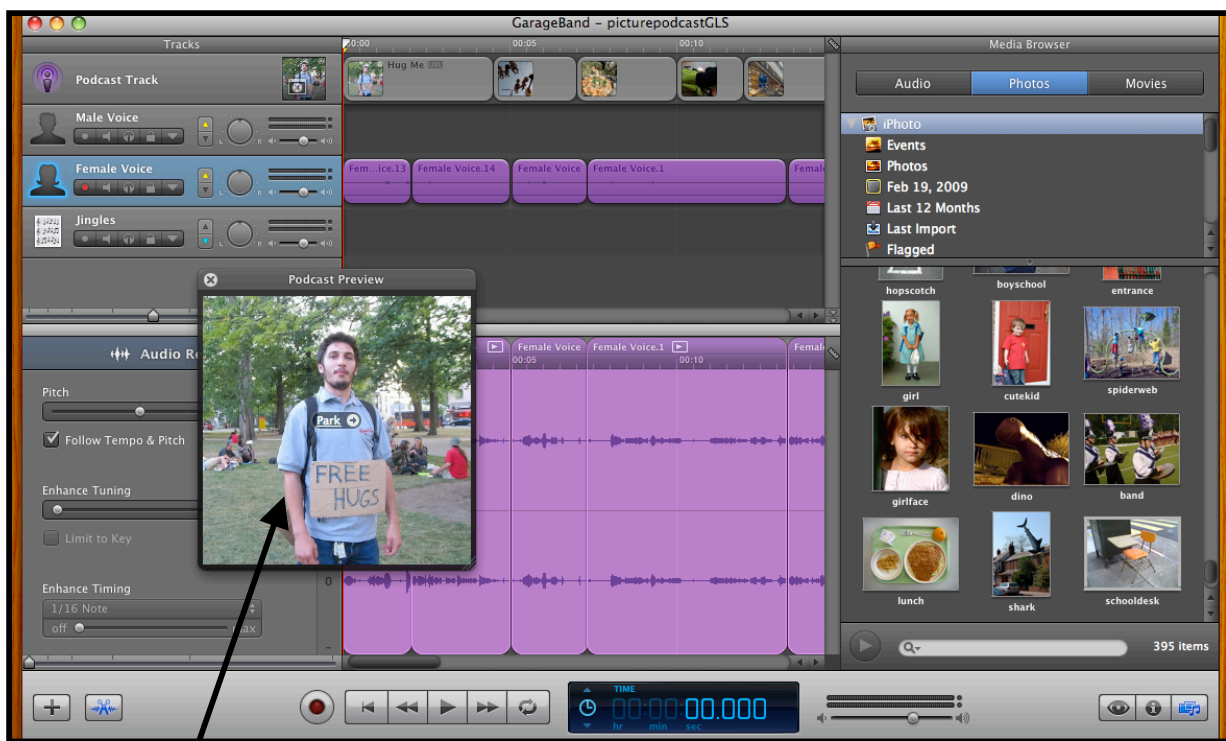
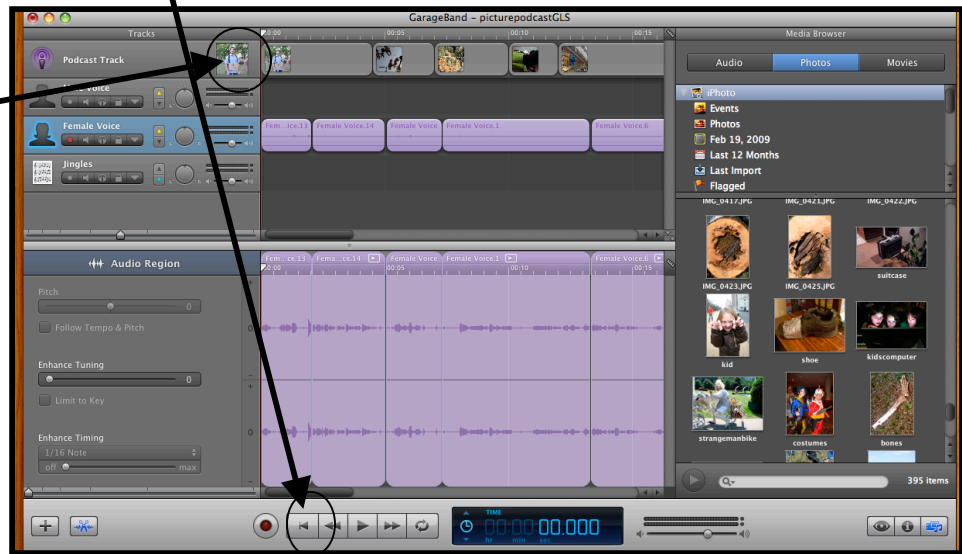


This is what it will look like after you move the tracks!

6. Go back to the beginning.

Click on the picture in the Podcast Track.

Watch and Listen to the recording many times to make sure that it is perfect! Make any changes you need to!
