Recording Your Voice

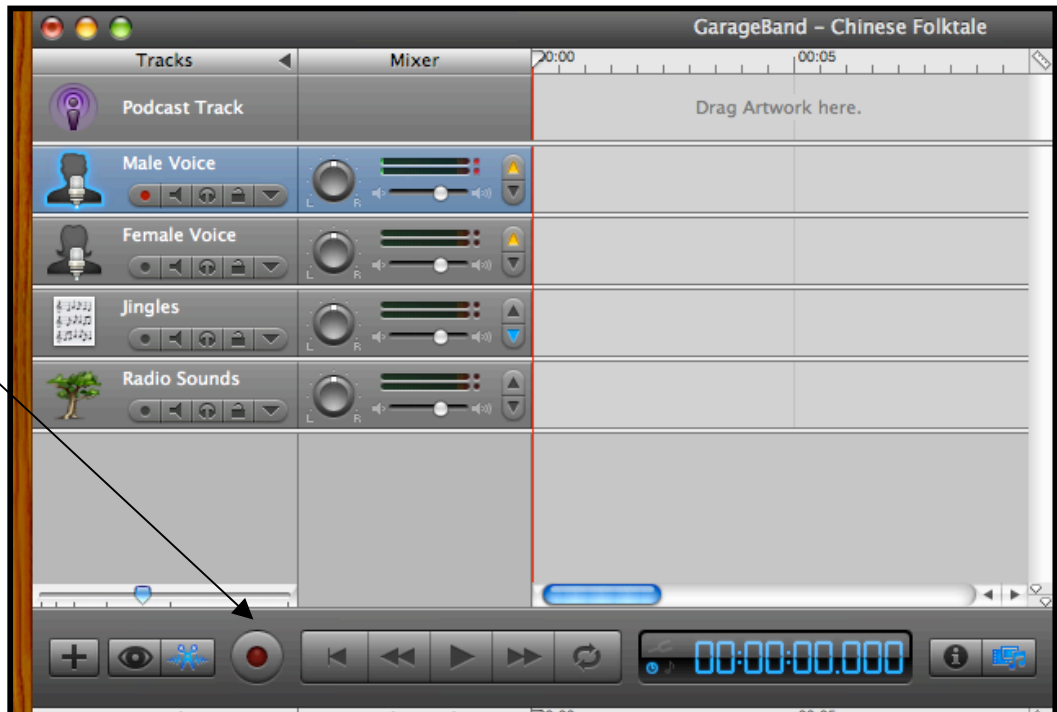

Click on the record button next to the male if you are a male, or next to the female if you are a female. This enables the track for recording.

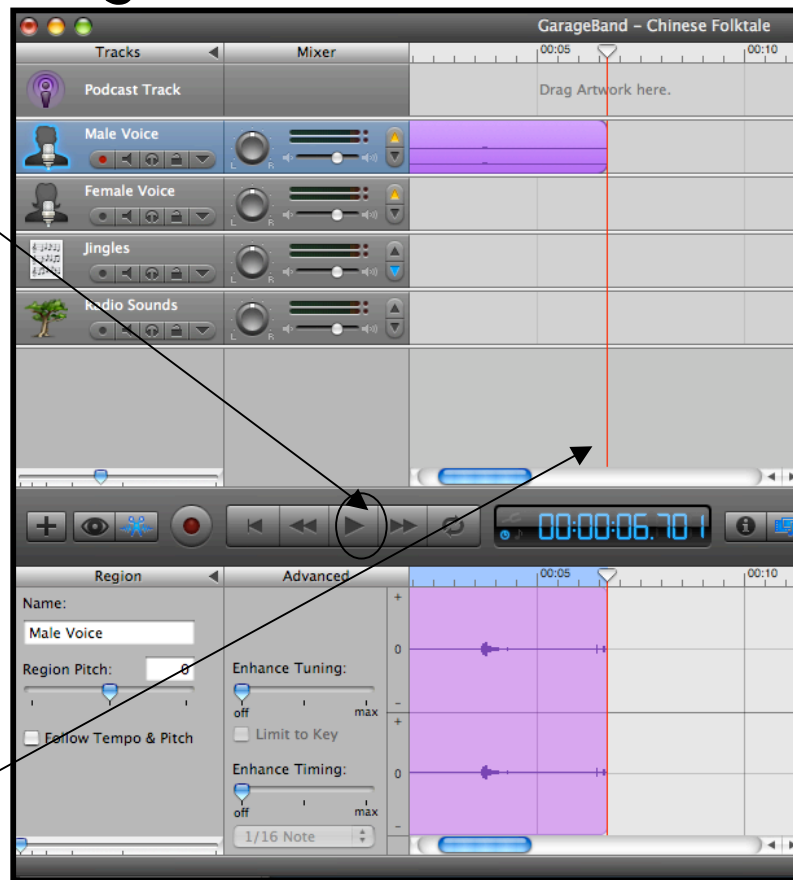
Now click this record button here to start recording. Make sure you speak clearly.



22. Recording Your Voice (continued)

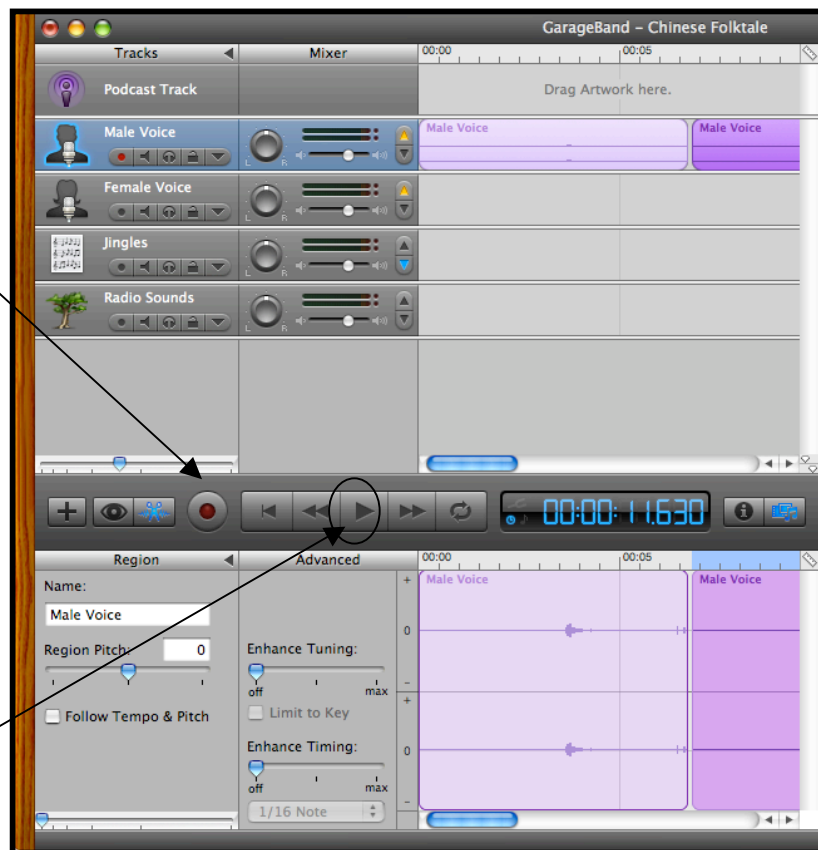
When you are done speaking, press the play button to pause the recording.

This red line is a bit like a cursor in word processing. It shows you where you are!

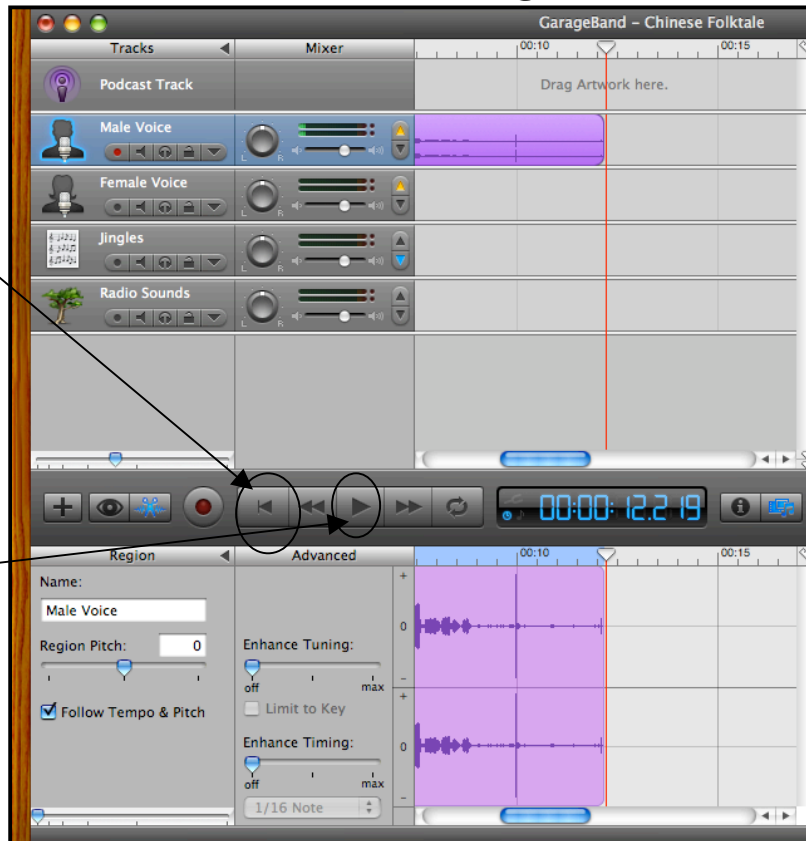
If you need to record more, just press the record button again. Keep doing steps 15 and 16 until you have finished recording all of the voice you have to record.

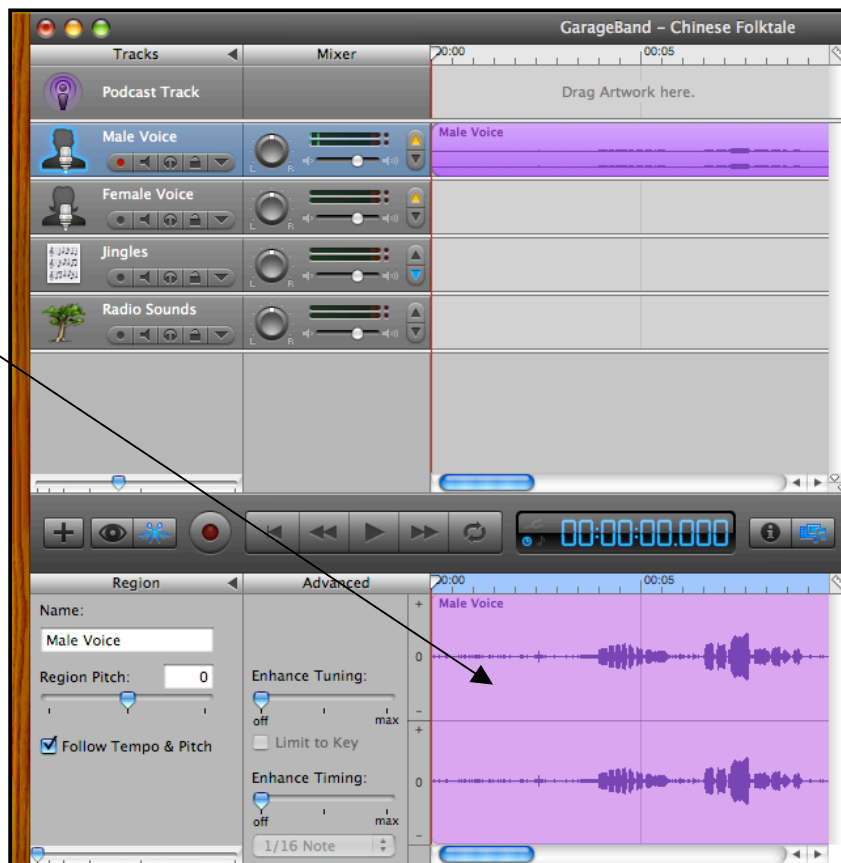

Click on this button to go back to the beginning of your recording.



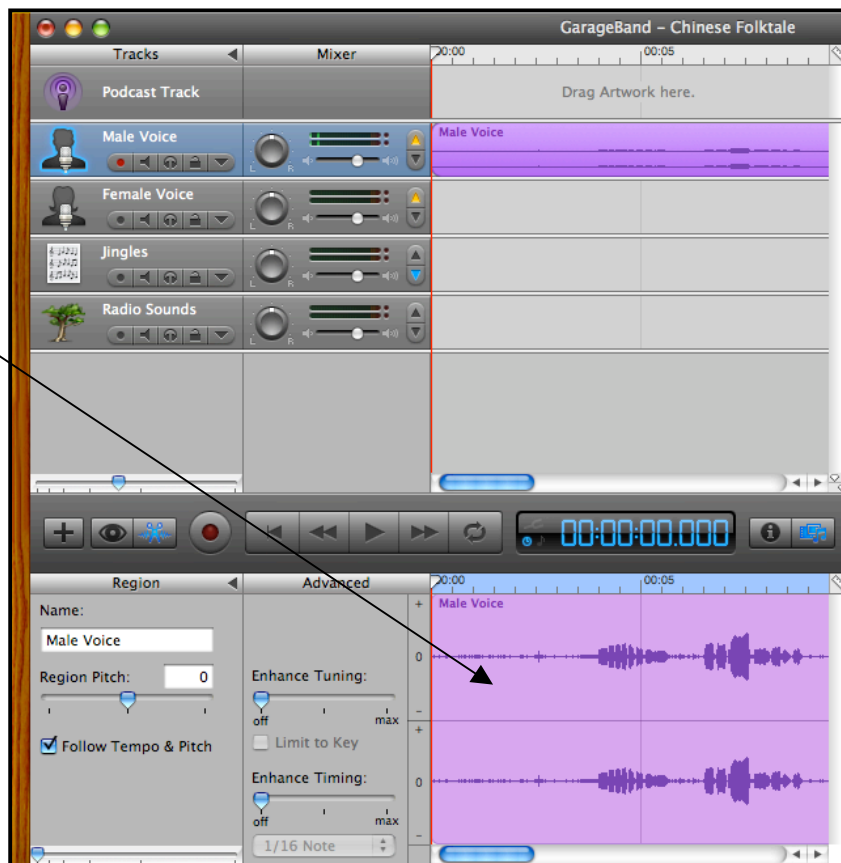

Click on the the track you recorded down in the track editor. After you click, the track should appear to be light purple in color.



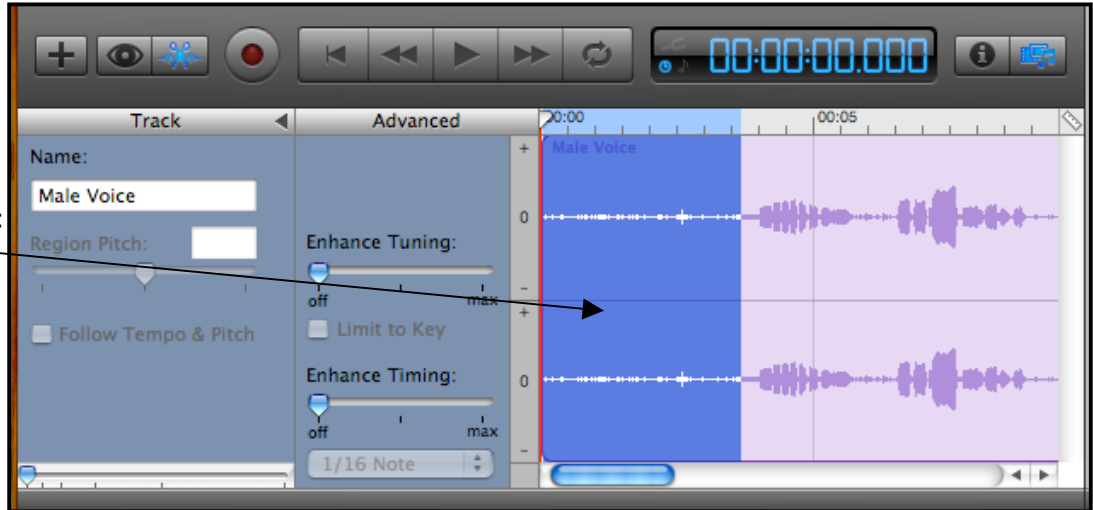
Editing (continued) Delete Part of the Recording

To delete part of the recording:

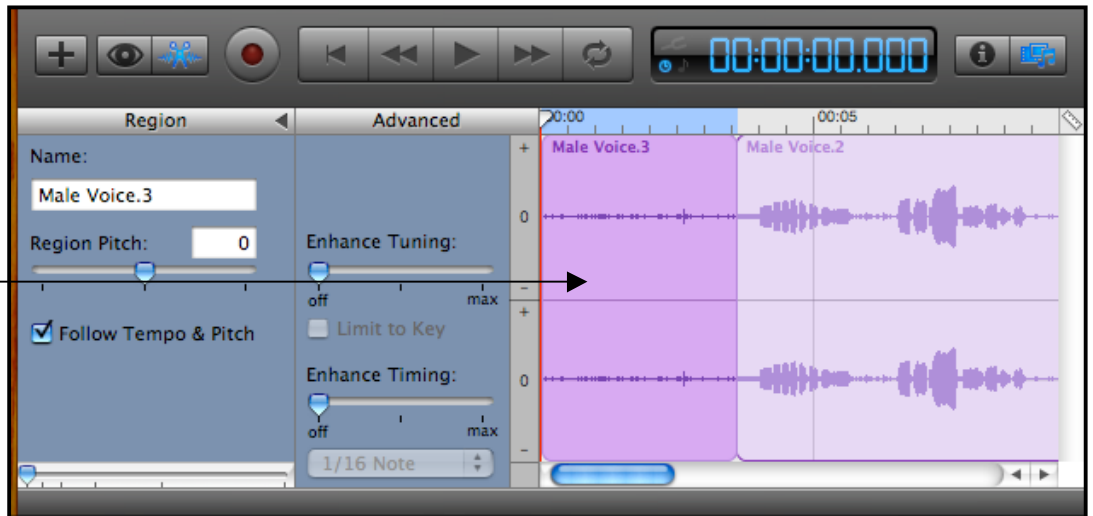
1. Make sure that your mouse looks like a plus sign.

2. Click and highlight the portion of the track that you want to delete.

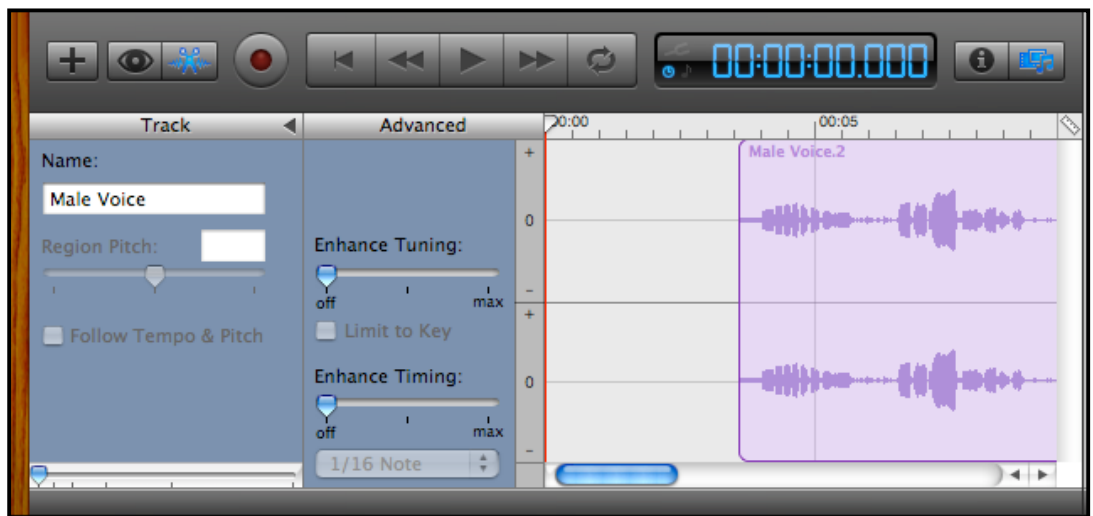
Click with your mouse on the portion you just highlighted.

Press the delete key on your keyboard.

*You will know that you did it correctly if the section you wanted to delete disappears.

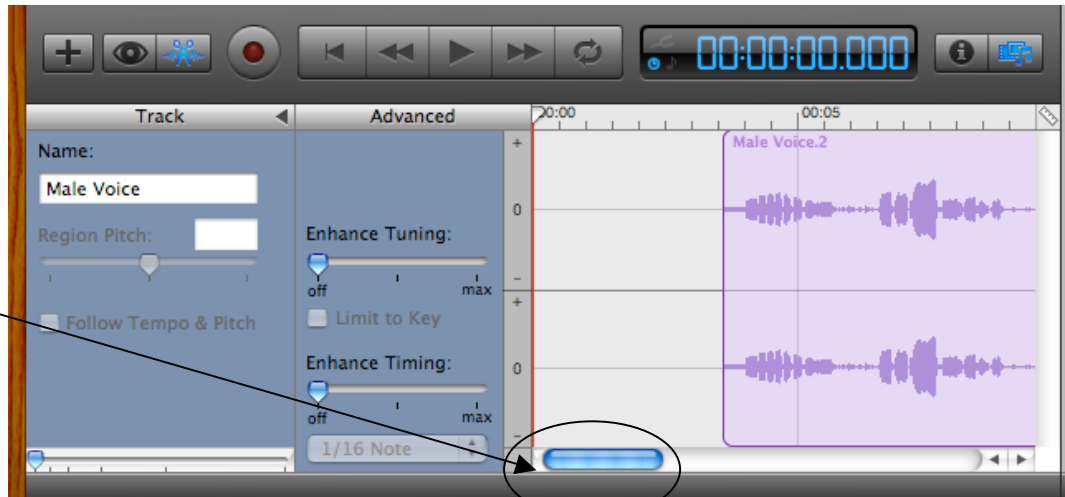


Editing (continued) Delete Part of the Recording

Use the blue slider to get to the next section you want to delete.

Once you are finished deleting unwanted recorded sound, You are ready to move the tracks together so that you do not have dead zones in your recording.

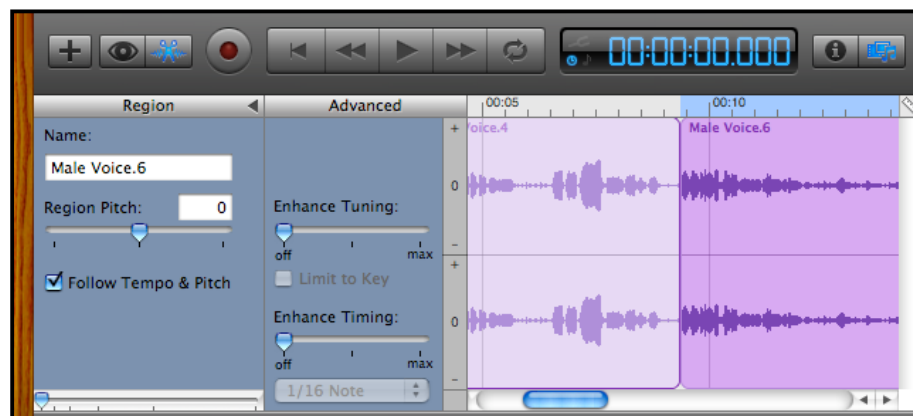
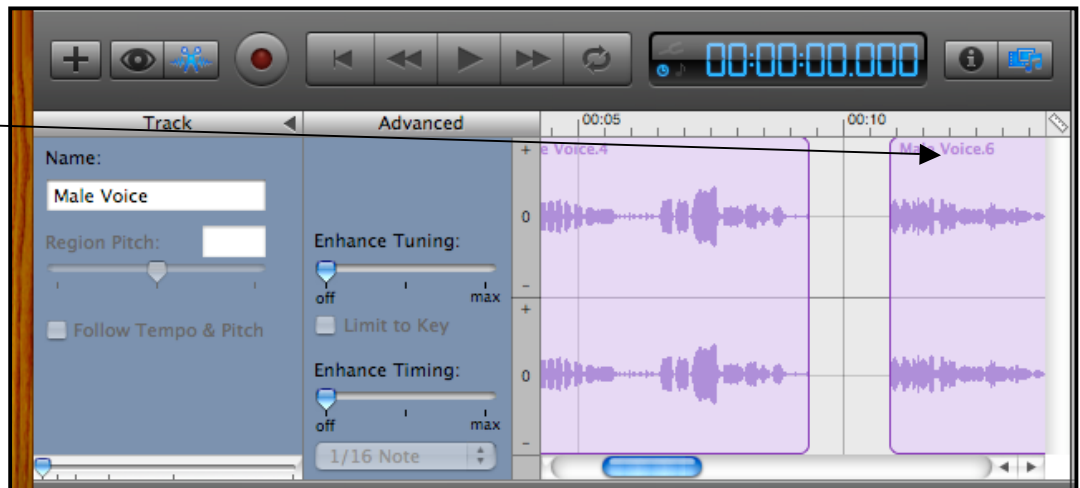


Delete Empty Spaces Between Recording

Put your mouse above the vertical lines that represent your voice. (Your mouse will look like a vertical line with two arrows on either side.)

Click on the section you want to move, and drag it to where you want it. Be careful not to put it on top of another recording!



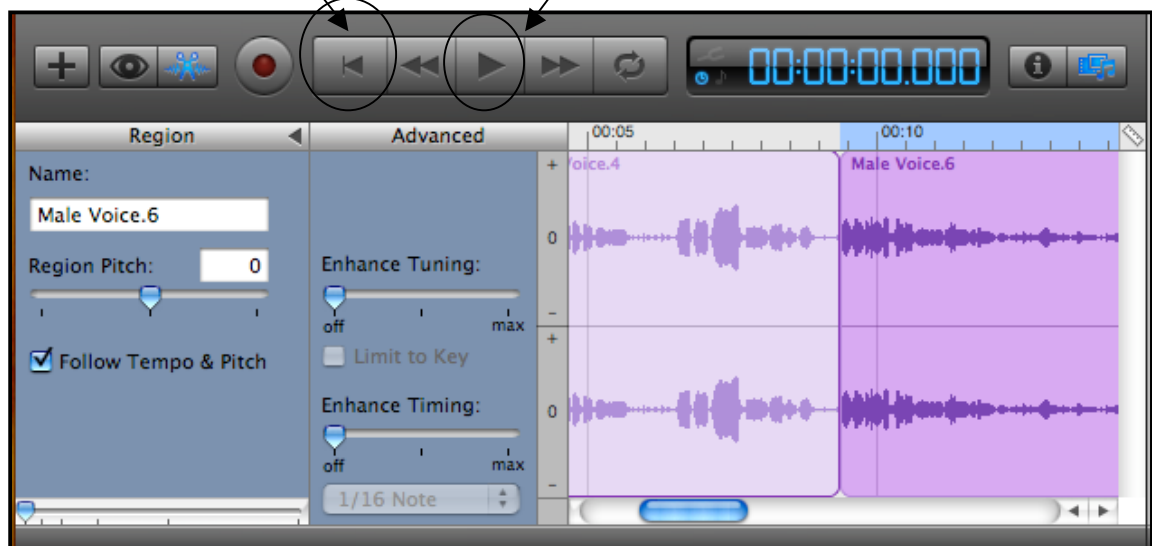
This is what it will look like after you move it!
