On Friday 14th of May and Friday 21st May all Prep students will have the opportunity to participate in a two-part fire education program developed and conducted by the Metropolitan Fire Brigade. A team of fire fighters will visit and discuss important factors of fire safety and appropriate fire safe behaviours, including how to respond in case of emergency, how to safely exit from a burning building and the stop, drop and roll technique.

The students will also be shown the various elements of the fire fighter's uniforms and weather permitting, may be given the chance to view a fire engine up close and use the fire hose. This program is free for primary school aged children and through visual, interactive and engaging activities, provides an age appropriate learning opportunity on such an important topic.
