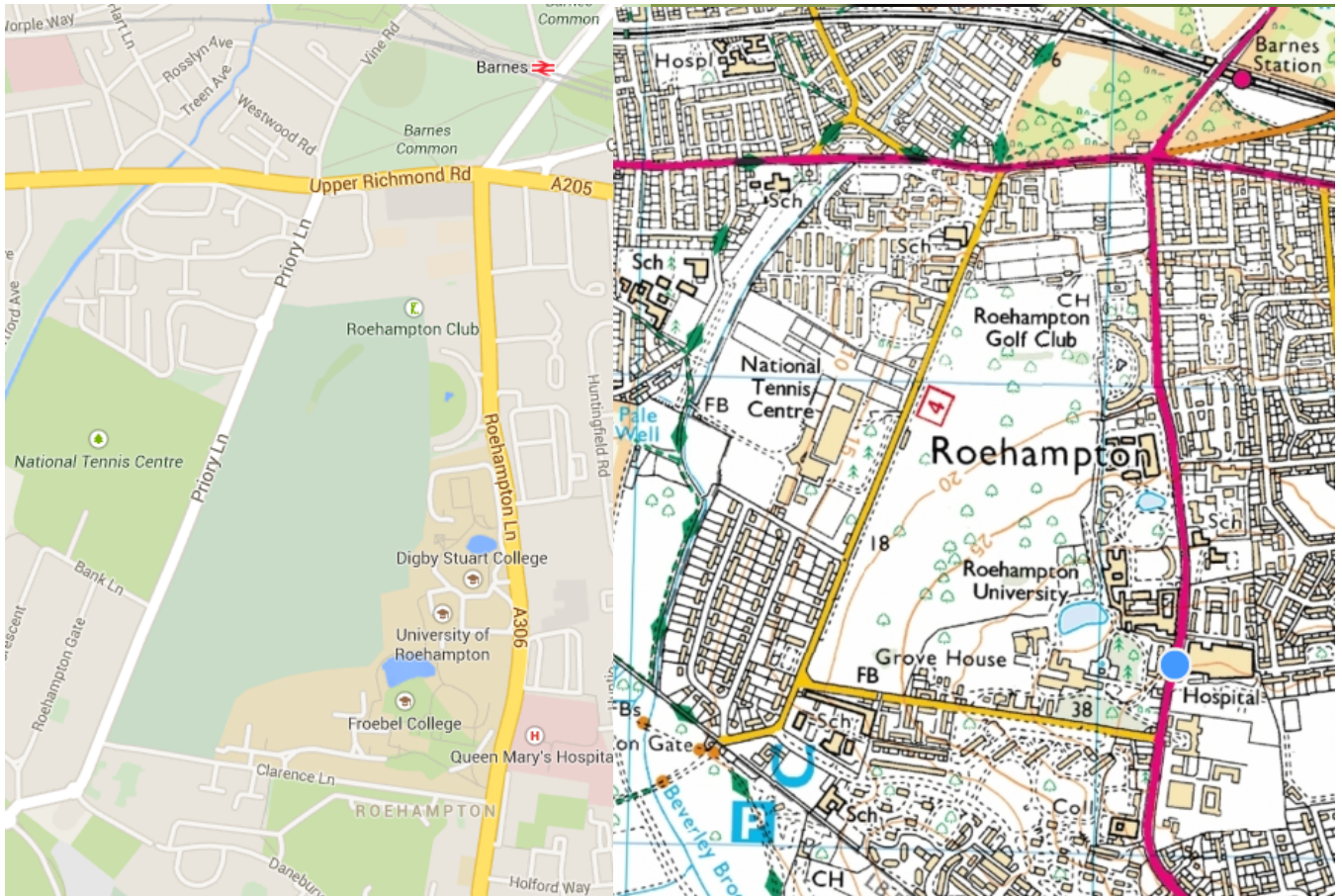


# CREATIVE MAPPING CHALLENGE
