World War II, Part 1

- Haile 19-5-12-1-19-19-9-5 was ruler of Ethiopia at the time of the Italian invasion.

- Hitler explained his plans and motivations in his book 13-5-9-14 11-1-13-16-6.

- A 19-1-14-3-20-9-15-14 is a penalty imposed by one or more countries against another.

- Germany 1-14-14-5-24-5-4 the Sudetenland in 1938.

- Axis leaders saw the Spanish Civil War as 16-18-1-3-20-9-3-5 for World War II.

- The 1-14-19-3-8-12-21-19-19 was the union of Austria with Germany in 1938.

- 1-16-16-5-1-19-5-13-5-14-20 is the avoidance of war by submitting to the demands of an aggressor.

- Hitler and Stalin divided 16-15-12-1-14-4 between themselves with the Nazi-Soviet Pact of 1939.

- Japan seized 13-1-14-3-8-21-18-9-1 in 1931.

- Edouard 4-1-12-1-4-9-5-18 was the leader of France in 1938.

The Rise of Benito Mussolini in Italy

- Mussolini established the world's first 20-15-20-1-12-9-20-1-18-9-1-14 state.

- Italians were disappointed to not win land in the 2-1-12-11-1-14-19 following World War I.

- Many Italian soldiers found themselves 21-14-5-13-16-12-15-25-5-4 following World War I.

- In 1919, Mussolini organized the 6-1-19-3-9-19-20 party.

- Mussolini sought to revive the ancient notion of the 13-5-4-9-20-5-18-18-1-14-5-1-14 as a Roman lake.

- Mussolini was asked to become prime minister by King Victor Emmanuel in 1922 following the Fascist "13-1-18-3-8 15-14 18-15-13-5."

- Mussolini's 2-12-1-3-11 19-8-9-18-20-19 wreaked havoc on their enemies in Italy.

- In 1929, the 12-1-20-5-18-1-14 20-18-5-1-20-9-5-19 recognized the independence of Vatican City.

- Mussolini went by the title 9-12 4-21-3-5 (meaning "the leader").

- Italy's army was staffed through 21-14-9-22-5-18-19-1-12 compulsory service.
