

Here are ways to help your child practice skills while having fun!

Day 1

Write these words: *raking, saved, trimming, walks, waving*. Have your child read each word and name the base word.

Day 2

Your child has been identifying the main idea and supporting details. After reading a story to your child, ask what the story is all about. Ask what the pictures say about the story's details.

Day 3

Write these words on strips of paper: *animals, full, early, eyes, warm, water*. Have your child read the words. Cut up each word into letters. Have your child put the letters together correctly to spell each word.

Day 4

Have your child write these spelling words: *dropped, dropping, excited, exciting, hugged, hugging, lifted, lifting, smiling, smiling, talked, talking*. Take turns making up sentences using the words.

Day 5

This week your child learned about statements and questions. Have your child write three questions for you to answer.

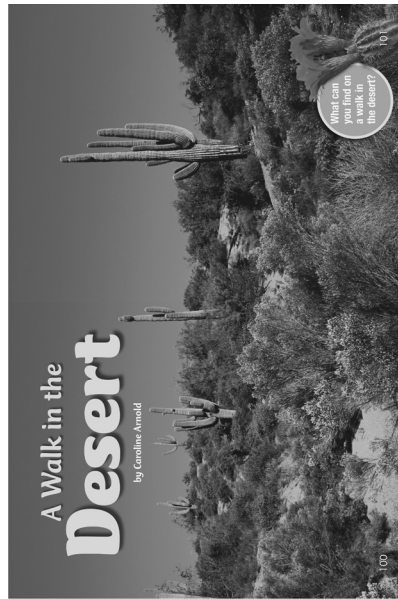
