**Canada** (KAN ə də) **Canada** is a nation in northern North America: Some people speak French in **Canada**. *NOUN***fearless** (FIR lis) A **fearless** person is afraid of nothing: Tom was **fearless** on the football field. *ADJECTIVE*

**slipped** (SLIPT) When you **slip**, you slide suddenly and unexpectedly: She **slipped** on the ice. *VERB***training** (TRĀ ning) If you are **training** for a job, you are learning the skills of the trade: I am **training** my dog to sit. *NOUN*
