“Be Proactive”

Students at the Elihu Greenwood Leadership Academy are being proactive by following the code of cooperation and being leaders and learners each day. If they choose otherwise, please be aware of the following consequences.

-After School Reflection

*Parents agree to make transportation arrangements to pick up their child promptly at 4:30pm if students exhibit:

- Excessive disruption of the learning environment
- Inappropriate language
- Defiant or argumentative behavior

-In House Suspension and Service Contribution to the School:

- For destruction of school property
- After 3 times of after school reflection for any of the listed behaviors within a month

-Immediate Out of School Suspension if students exhibit:

- Dangerous behavior;
- Dangerous objects; or
- Serious destruction of school property; or
- After 3 in house suspensions for any of the listed behaviors within a grading period.

“Put First Things First”

Parents of Elihu Greenwood Leadership Academy students are expected to help their child with their homework daily.

Parents will:

- Read and/or monitor their child's daily reading for at least 20 minutes; and
- Review their child's homework.

Students should do their best on their homework. Students who do not complete their homework will not be allowed to attend special school events.

“Synergize”

At the Elihu Greenwood Leadership Academy, synergizing is key to our success. We are a community of leaders and learners; uniforms help us demonstrate this unity.

Students who do wear their uniforms daily will be included in special events and field trips. In order to be eligible for leader of the month, students must wear their uniforms daily.

Students who do not wear their uniform will not be able to attend special events, field trips, or be leader of the month.
