\* Beginning in Spring 2014, STAAR English I and English II EOCs will measure Reading and Writing achievement through a single assessment given in one day and students will receive a single score. To provide flexibility for students who have taken STAAR English I and/or English II EOCs in 2011-12 or 2012-13 (when those assessments consisted of separate tests in Reading and Writing), TEA is proposing that through the December 2013 administration of STAAR EOCs students can meet their English I and English II graduation requirements by meeting 3 criteria (applied within each course, not across courses):

1. Passing one assessment (either Reading or Writing) at the Level II Phase 1 standard (1875 scale score)
2. Meeting at least the Minimum Score on the other assessment
3. Achieving a combined scale score of 3750 which represents the sum of the scale scores needed to reach Level II Phase 1 for Reading (1875) and Writing (1875)

\*\* Because Minimum Score is not a cutpoint for a Performance Level (e.g., Level II or Level III), it does not necessarily equate to a specific raw score on an assessment. The raw score identified in this column represents the lowest raw score that results in a scale score that is equal to or greater than the Minimum Score.

**Note:** The raw scores and percentages reported in this table **ONLY** apply to the Spring 2013 Paper Administration STAAR assessments. Within each Phase, the **SCALE SCORE** remains consistent from year to year. The raw score cut points are likely to vary from year to year. The 2013 raw score cut points reported in this table are useful in serving as **approximations** or **reasonable estimates** of applicable cut points in 2014 (or future years).
