This event is geared to parents for students in grade five through twelve. The program will be on Wednesday, April 25 from 7:00pm to 8:00pm and hosted in the Adams Middle School library. The presenters for this district program include Dr. Bradford Jackson, Holliston Police Chief John J. Moore, Detective David Gatchell and John Harutunian, Adams Assistant Principal.

The agenda will include two brief presentations and a lengthy question and answer session:

- Dr. Jackson/John Harutunian will present about the benefits and risks associated with adolescent use of social media as well as share recommended strategies from respected national organizations for parents to use to help guide and model for their children how to behave safely, responsibly, and respectfully in the growing world of social media.
- Chief Moore and Detective Gatchell will explain some of the cyber risks and cyber safety issues from a law enforcement perspective as well as describe inappropriate actions and humor that may lead to civil rights violations or hate crimes. In addition, they will clarify the current marijuana laws since the decriminalization initiative and social host issues from civil and criminal consequences.
