### Make your product/outcome

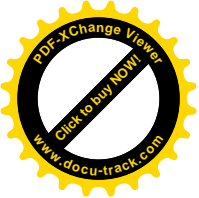

It is vital that as you go through the creation process, you reflect seriously in terms of your Area of Interaction focus and in terms of whether you are making progress to achieving your goal/specifications.

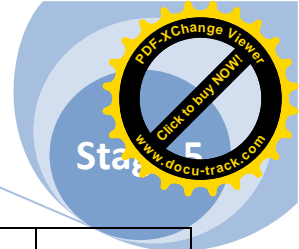
### Evaluate the product/outcome
