
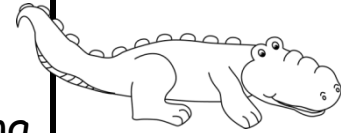


MSV Cheat Sheet


Meaning =

- The student **looks at the picture** to think about what may 'fit' in the context.
- The reader thinks about the primary meaning of the text and thinks:
"What would make sense?"



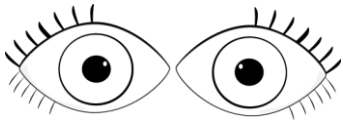
Alligator?

Structure =

Look at ~~me~~ ice cream!

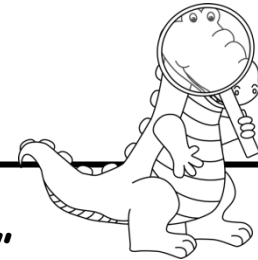


- The student thinks:
"Would it sound right to say it that way?"
- The structure of the text
(up to and including the substitution) should follow acceptable English Language construction.



Visual =

- The student thinks:
"Does it look like the word in the text?"
- The student **notices** what the letters and words look like.
