

Ten Frame Flash!

Dear Teacher,

Thank you for downloading my product! This game is perfect for a kindergarten math center or partner activity. It helps develop number sense and fluency, and the kids love it! Here's how to play:

1. Player 1 quickly shows one of the ten frames with dots in it to Player 2 for 3 seconds (counting 1-2-3). Then, Player 1 hides the ten frame.
2. On the blank ten frame sheet (laminated these and use dry erase markers), Player 2 draws how many dots he or she saw. Player 2 then tells Player 1 how many dots they think there were.
3. The two students check the drawing together to make sure it is correct. Player 1 can either help Player 2 correct the drawing, or give positive feedback.

Play this game in a small group a couple of times before you introduce it as an independent center. When you play it with the kids, make explicit the strategies you can use to quickly notice how many dots there are (counting blank squares, quickly counting a small number of dots, noticing how many more/less than 5 or 10 there are, etc.). Included in this freebie are four different sets of ten frames with dots, each in a different color. This will help you keep separate the different sets of the cards if you have multiple sets out.
