

Saving

To Save click the **ToonDoo** Icon,
then click the **Floppy Disk Icon**.



Saving

Enter a Title.

Entering a Description is optional.

Entering Tags is optional.

Let Others Redo should be checked when using the private saving option. This allows users to continue to edit their projects at a later time.

Click **Keep it Private!** when a project is still in progress or to keep projects for classroom use only. The private saving options is the best way to keep projects secure.

Click **Publish to the World!** when a project is finished and to embed a project on a classroom website, blog, or wiki. When publishing to the world, change your profile settings to block comments from other users.
