**Developed Nation:** country that has a high level of development according to some criteria. Examples include a stable democratic government, a free economy, a government with little to no corruption, a large GDP, an industrial or service based economy, high technological use, and a well developed infrastructure. High standard of living.

Example: USA

**Developing Nation (also called newly industrialized):** Countries which have advanced on some levels as a country but not all. Contains a mix of political, economic, corruption, GDP, Economy, Technological Use, and Infrastructure. Can have either a high or low standard of living

Example: CHINA

**Undeveloped Nation:** nation with a low level of material well-being. Often characterized Corrupt dictatorships, little to no infrastructure, a low GDP, agricultural industry, command or trade economies, low technological use, and a low standard of living.
