When you have finished your map test get together with a partner to work on peer review of your papers SILENTLY.

Check your partner's paper for:

- Spelling and Grammar
- Clarity (is anything confusing)
- Does your partner's paper have 3 EASILY IDENTIFIABLE sources?
- Does your partner's paper have and EASILY IDENTIFIABLE thesis statement?
- Does your partner's paper have an introduction, 3 body paragraphs, and a conclusion?
- Does your partner defend their thesis?
- Were you left with any questions?

- IF YOU HAD TO GRADE THIS PAPER RIGHT NOW WHAT GRADE WOULD YOU GIVE IT?

- Be honest. If you give them an A that you don't think they have earned you are hurting your partner. Let them know where they stand so they can fix their mistakes.

On the bottom or back of your partner's paper write your name with three things the paper does well, three things that could be improved, and their grade at this point.
