Mongolia

90% of the people are Mongols

Country is landlocked

Landlocked- country that is surrounded by land on all four sides

Country is covered by the Gobi Desert and Steppes

Steppes- dry treeless plain at the edge of a desert

History of Mongolia

Early Mongolians were Nomads

Nomad- people who have no home and follow herds of animals

Nomads live in yurts, tent like structures

Genghis Khan

He was a great military leader that build a huge Empire

Empire- a collection of different areas under one ruler

Was born under the name Temujin
