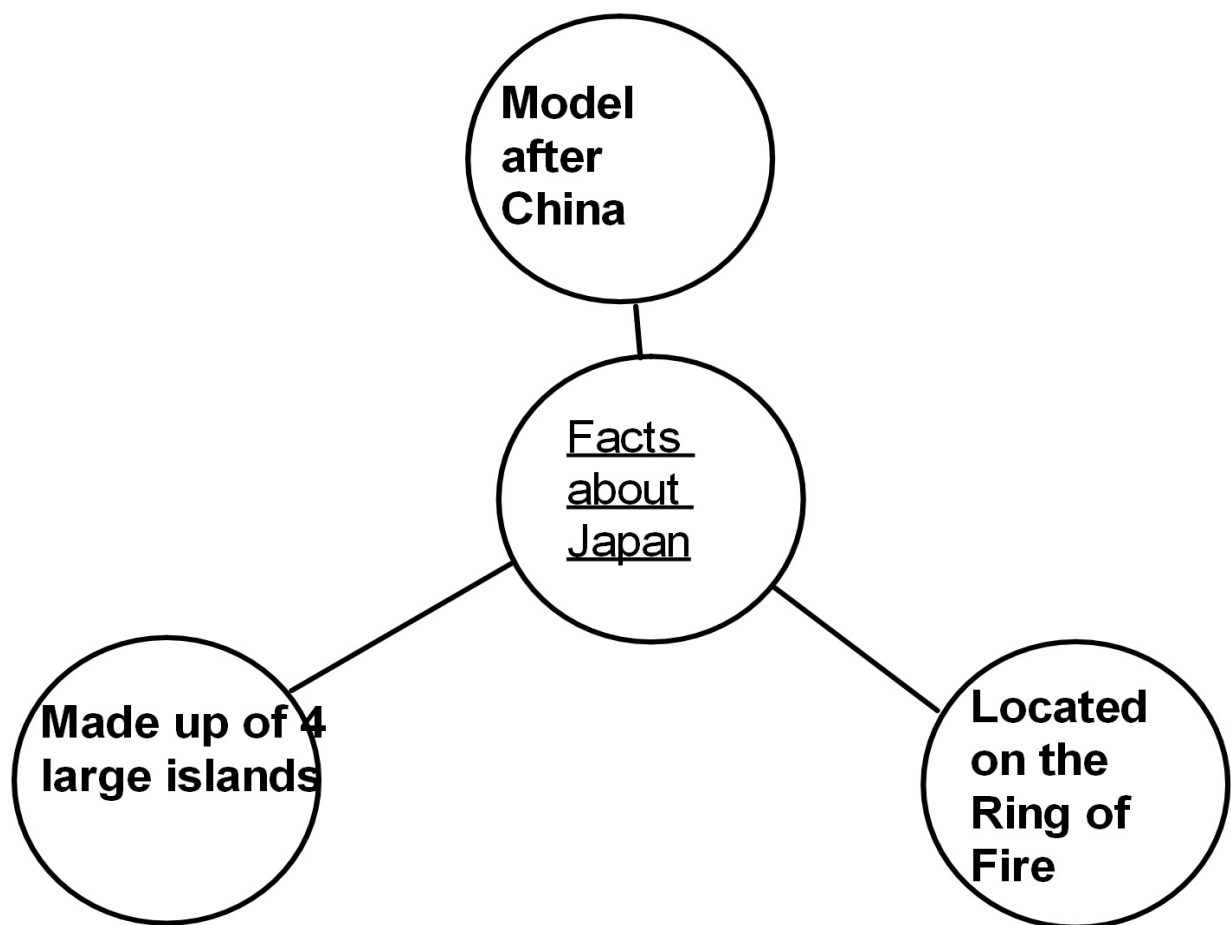
Capital City: **Tokoyo**

Mount Fuji

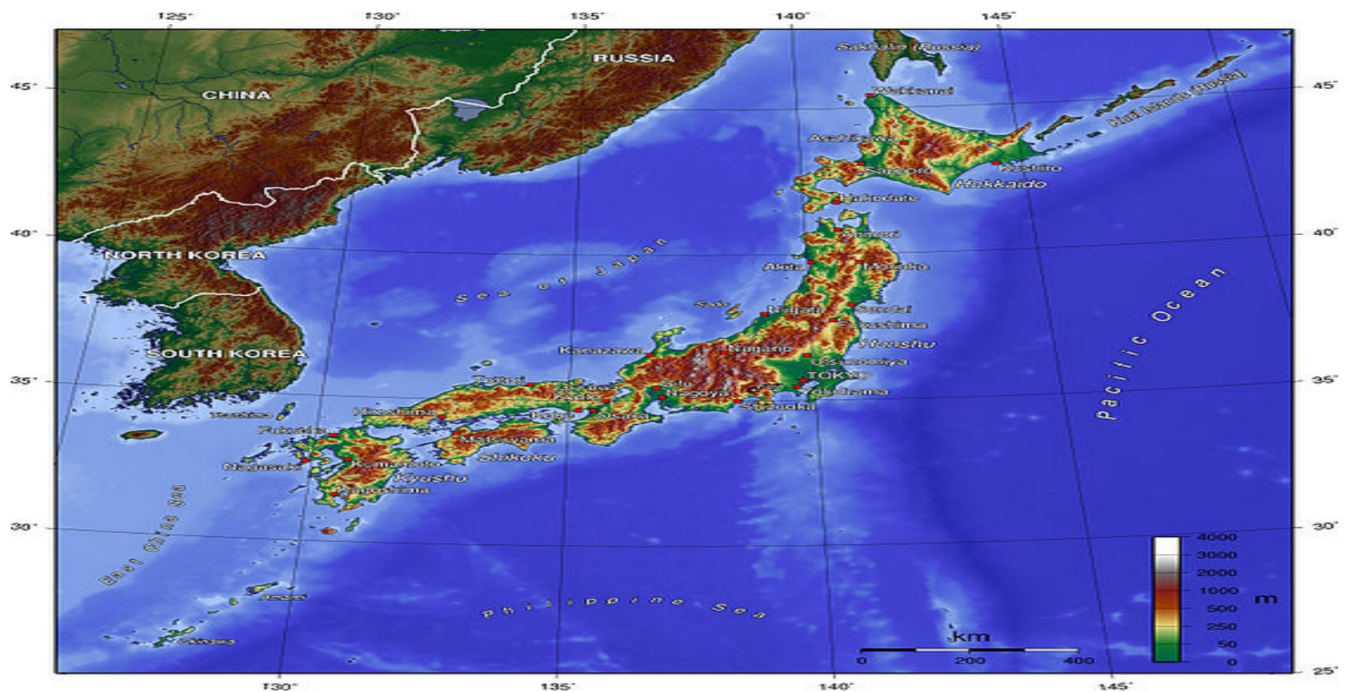
Mount Fuji is the National Symbol of Japan

There are many environmental laws in Japan that protect fish of the coast and surrounding waters of Japan

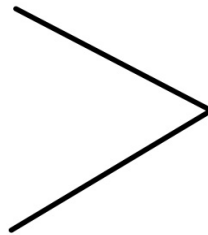
Industry in Japan

The Atomic Bomb was created in Los Alamos, New Mexico under the Code Name Manhattan Project

The order to drop the Atomic Bomb was given by President Harry S. Truman

The Two Atomic Bombs Dropped on Japan

First bomb dropped on Japan was "Little Boy" on August 7, 1945

It was dropped on the city of Hiroshima

Plane that dropped "Little Boy" on Hiroshima

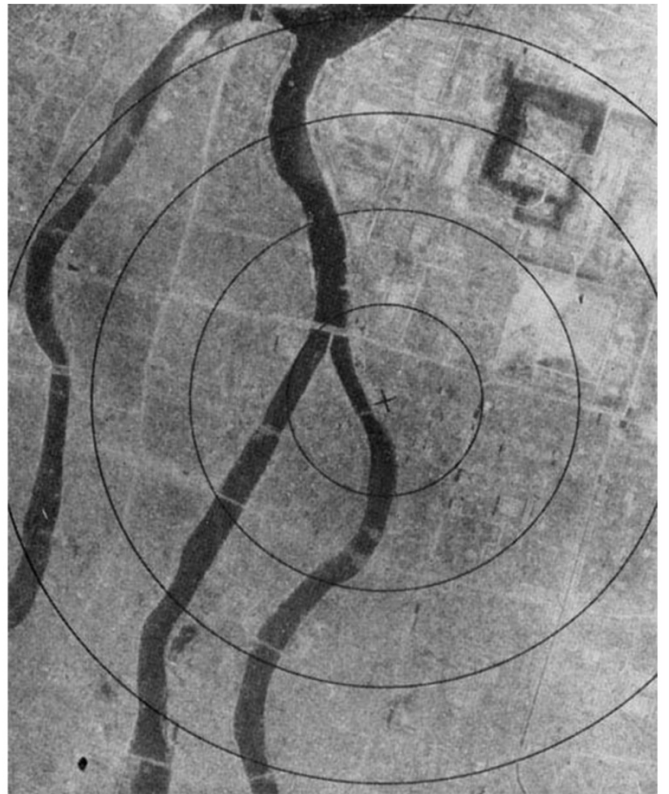
Pilot Paul Tibbets name the plane after his mother
