Materials:

blank cards with 9, 16, or 25 blocks, copy of the words being studied

How to Play:

Have the students fill in their cards with the words that they are working on. Tell them that each card must be different and that they need to try to mix up the words that they are using. Playing the game is similar to Bingo. The teacher calls out the words and has the students spell out loud and then mark their

spaces. (Spelling the words out loud will give those who are unsure of the word some extra help.) The first child to cover an entire row calls out the word, "Wordo!" The winner can call out the words next time.
