A. Typhoon Summary (Information source: Central Weather Bureau)

Typhoon Nanmadol was located at 390 km away from the south southeastern of Eruanbi on August 27, the 100th year of ROC at 14:00 with Grade 7 wind storm, 180 km in radius, Grade 10 storm with 50 km in radius, speed of 9 km/hr, moving toward north northwestern. At present its center is located at northern inshore of Luzon Ireland, moving in the direction of north northwestern that shall threaten to Bashi Channel as well as the southeastern sea of Taiwan.

Currently there is no report for the disaster.

F. Status on Disaster Reaction Center Operation

I. Central Disaster Reaction Center was established after Central Weather Bureau announcing the alarm of Typhoon Nanmadol at 5:30 on the 27th. The group and department start to reside for operation. They notified each department and commission as well as each county and municipal government to pay higher attention to that by strengthening precaution, avoiding land sliding, rock falling, earth flowing

and mountain torrents breaking out. We have established the shelters extensively in those areas might happen the disaster, provide the evacuation and taking refuge for publics. At the same time we also paid attention to the strengthening of scaffolds, road trees and advertisement boards. We shall evacuate the residence from the dangerous areas to the safe places in advance. For those near the sea and low area, we shall pay attention to the back flow of sea water.

II. At 10:30 of the 27th, Chongqiu, Huang, Deputy Commander hosted the 1st working meeting and made instruction to each department and commission to strengthen the monitoring of typhoon and provide the status to the local government for reference. They also need to strengthen the publicity to do their best to avoid the activity to the mountain area and outdoor activity alongside the sea. Each unit shall continue to keep close communication with each county and municipal government and master the status on the rainfall in each area. They also notified the local government to prepare for the preventative evacuation, preventative measurement for those projects in construction as well as the preparation for the sheltering areas. The National Army has finished their advance arrangement as well as the military arrangement, established each communication mechanism and assisted the local government to implement the preventative evacuation and sheltering work.
