## Required Information

This portion of the Wiki assignment builds on the Wiki you created in the first step of the project. Note: the guidelines surrounding the goals, rationale, sources and documentation, and evaluation criteria remain in effect for this part of the task.

## Specific Details

- ☐ Choose a minimum of 10 Web 2.0 tools that interest you
- ☐ Create a page in your wiki for each of the Web 2.0 tools (10 tools = 10 pages) you select to focus on
- ☐ Include the following information for each of the Web 2.0 tools on the appropriate Wiki pages:
  - Brief description of the tool (2 to 3 sentences)
  - Completed example of the tool (example should relate directly to literacy; if example is stored in an online forum, provide direct link so that it can be accessed easily)
  - Short discussion of pros and cons for the tool's classroom implementation
  - Summarized section on possible classroom uses
  - Note: all of the information detailed in bullets 1 – 4 may be presented via a chart (1 chart per tool, housed on the respective the wiki page)
- ☐ Select 2 of the Web 2.0 tools you chose (these should be ones that you feel fairly certain you will be able to implement in your classroom, either to complement your teaching or for student completion) and create step-by-step directions for using the Web 2.0 tool.
