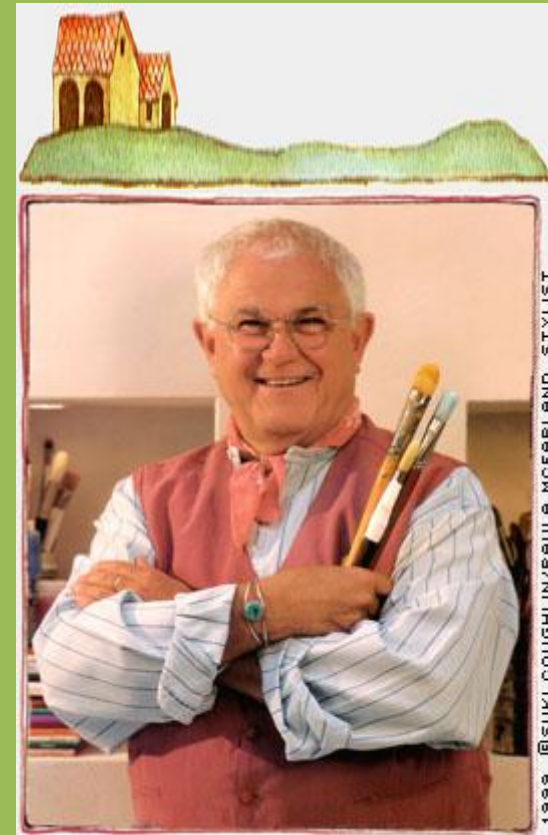

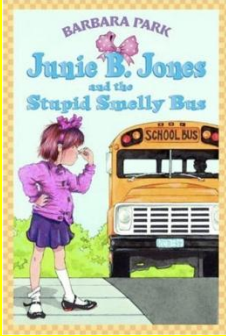

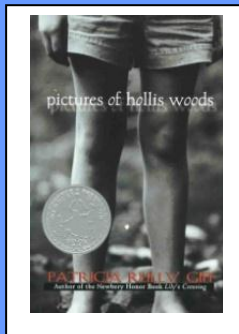

My name is Amelia "Melly" Hazelwood, and I welcome you to my site. I decided to create this site first and foremost, to educate the public about my experiences with PT-1—the vaccine that reversed the aging process for me some 85 years ago.
