Pick 4 vocabulary words that you either don't know the meaning of or are important to the understanding of the text. Complete a frayer model card for each word.

### Details

What are 3 details from the text that support the main idea?

### Questions

After reading the selection, develop 3 critical thinking questions about what you read.

### Visual Images

Choose a diagram, chart, graph, map or image that is important to the text. Draw the image and explain its significance to the text.

### Summary

Use the 5Ws and H (who, what, when, where, why, how) to summarize what you read.
