

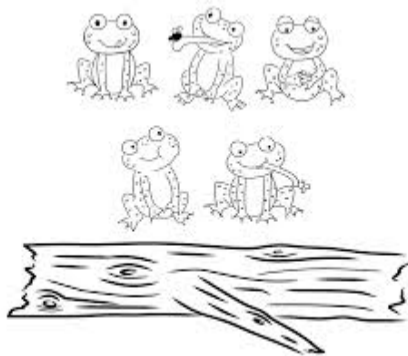
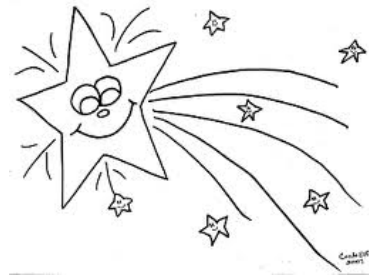
Read the poems and find the rhyming words.
