


Room layout for a debate



The debating teams sit behind tables facing the audience.

- First Speaker sits nearest the Chair, then Second, then Third.
- The Chair sits behind a table facing the audience.
- The Adjudicator sits at a table at the back of the audience.
- The Timekeeper usually sits in the front row of the audience.

Each speaker, when called, moves forward to the centre of the room.

The speaker stands in front of the Chairperson to address the audience.
