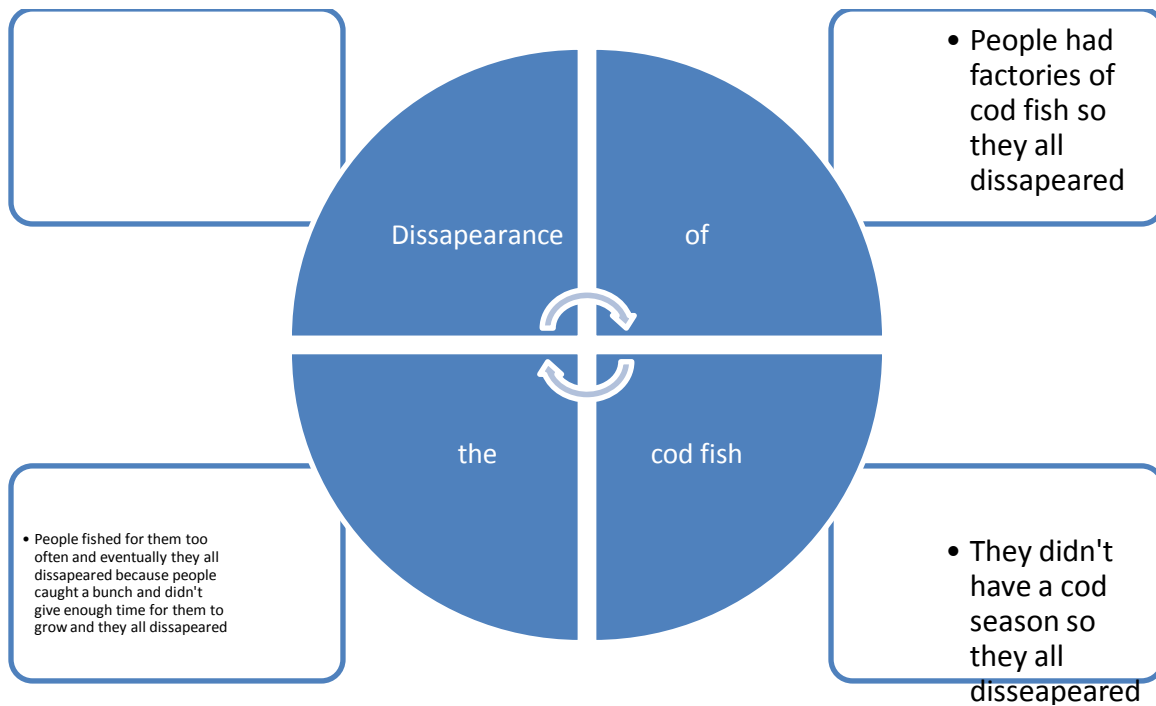
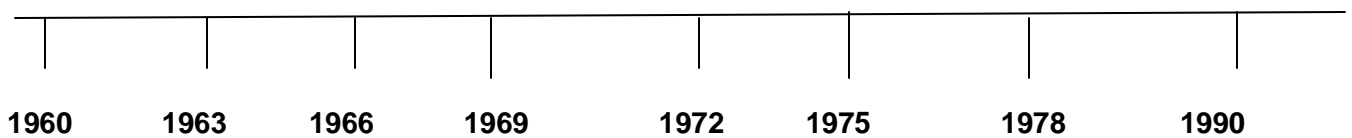


1. Make a web chart to show three different reasons for the disappearance of cod. Record two facts for each reason.
