



THE BRIDGE OF LIES

After more than 200 years, the Bridge of Lies, which was rebuilt in the meantime, continues to be as important for the citizens as it was in the past. Most locals avoid crossing the bridge, for fear that it will collapse the weight of their lies.

Elders in the past said that the bridge has ears, unimaginable power intuition, so at every untruth uttered, the bridge begins to moan in all joints, and a noise that gives you shivers, starts to break down. In a few minutes, it brings the bridge down to earth, literally and figuratively.

Lies prove to be stronger than wood or iron, and the bridge breaks under her weight.

The market traders are also afraid of this bridge because strange things happened on it after negotiating their goods.

Thus there is a scare that makes traders that arrived in Hermannstadt next time not to deceive the citizens of Sibiu. The tastiest legend that binds to the name of the bridge is one of the couple who used to walk on the bridge. It is said that young lovers, passing during the night the bridge and swearing eternal love to each other. If they don't respect their words after the wedding night, if they cross the bridge they will be dragged and thrown from the bridge.

The Bridge of Lies is a symbol of Sibiu and is the first wrought iron bridge in Romania. It was rebuilt in 1859 by Fredericus Hutte after chronicles spoke before about a wooden bridge.
