<p style="text-align: center;">Collaboration:</p> <p>Students could use this for feedback from other students around the work...Asking questions and hearing the correct answer from someone who has been there to experience it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Collaboration:</p> <p>Utilizing the “Teachers” and “Education” tag on Tumblr, you are able to ask questions and share sources with other teachers.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Brainstorm Ideas:</p> <p>Students are able to use this to post an idea generator, where they write a topic, and consistently update it when they can, or if other peers can provide assistance with their brainstorming process.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Feedback:</p> <p>Utilizing the same features of the “Teachers” and “Education” tag on Tumblr teachers are able to work through what went wrong in a lesson, and what they can change and work to make better as well as appeal to their population they are teaching.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Organization:</p> <p>Students are able to use this by making notes on a regular basis of ideas, topics, questions they have- and saving it all in a place where they cannot lose it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Shared Classrooms:</p> <p>Collaboration and working with another teacher who has a Tumblr, allows for sharing classroom spaces, and collaboration with other activities like a writer’s workshop[peer feedback]</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Feedback From Professionals:</p> <p>Students are able to ask and utilize professional individuals who spend their life learning about topics they have questions about.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Online workshops:</p> <p>Sharing powerpoints, viewing online sources and furthering their own knowledge about content, technology, and education overall.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Virtual Word Wall:</p> <p>Posting a word a day, with a definition, its relationship to the topic, and where they will encounter it on the a regular basis will provide students a way to learn and develop their own content specific vocabulary. Along with this students can post words they find interesting and new to share with the class.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Gallery Workshop:</p> <p>Posting pictures that are relevant to the content, or classroom photos allow for outsiders or students to grasp a better understanding of the content that is being presented</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Timeline Events:</p> <p>Students are able to write responses, post pictures, and quotes among many other things that chronicle an event or live-time blog events. This can be for such things that have already happen like “WWI” or even pretend to</p>	

be a reporter during a book reporting the events for example for "The Great Gatsby"	
<p>Group Editing:</p> <p>This relates to the sample lesson posted, but posting student work, and having students edit and revise one another's pieces.</p>	
<p>Publishing Factor:</p> <p>Allows motivation for students to work on assignments knowing it will be out there for the world to see.</p>	
<p>Multi-media within:</p> <p>Post photos, videos, audio about content related topics for students to have to supplement classroom objectives that you were not able to cover within class time.</p>	
<p>Class Tumblr:</p> <p>Posting pictures of the class, student work, and other things the class as a whole is proud of, or posing questions for others to answer as a class</p>	
<p>Vocabulary Word of the Day:</p> <p>Similar to the word wall, but can be posted as a class, that way they feel they are contributing.</p>	
<p>Classroom Website- supplemental:</p> <p>Used as a newsletter type ordeal, posting homework, news, questions for them to respond to, worksheets etc.</p>	
<p>Travel back in time/embody historical figure/writer:</p> <p>Similar to real time writing posts, or timeline-ing, this involves students writing from a specific individual and posting from their perspective.</p>
