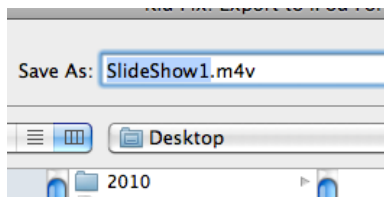
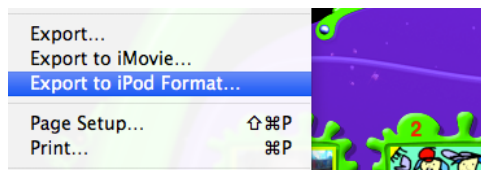


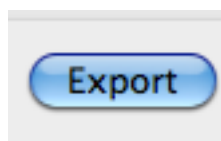
## Linking a Kid-Pix Slideshow

After you have made your slideshow with the transitions, sounds and time go to File---- Export to iPod Format

Click on Export

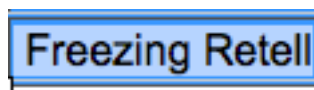


Once complete look for it on your desktop or folder.

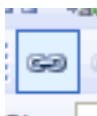


Go into K-Net and click edit on the page you want the slideshow to be uploaded.

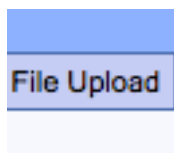
On the blank page type in the name of the slideshow and highlight it.



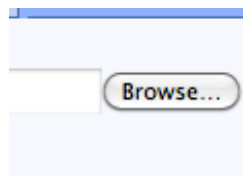
Click on the link icon.



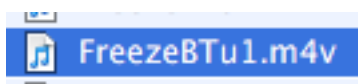

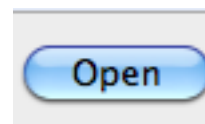

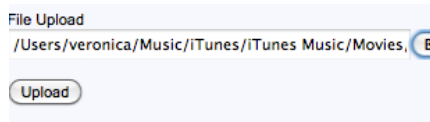


Click on the one you want to upload



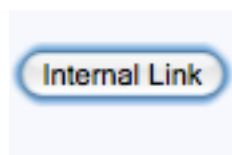
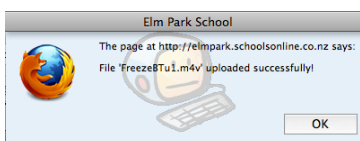
Click Open



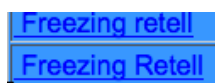
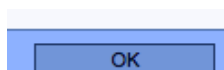
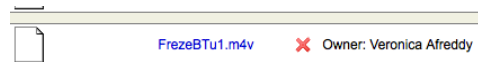


Click upload when you see this.

Click on Internal Link and then on the .m4v file you want to create a link to.

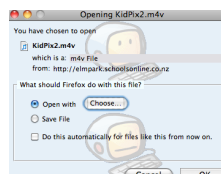


Click OK.

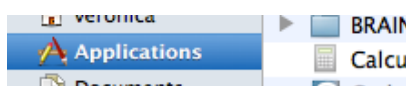
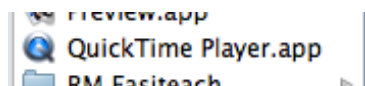
This is what the link looks like.

Do not forget to SAVE!

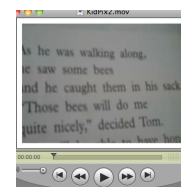
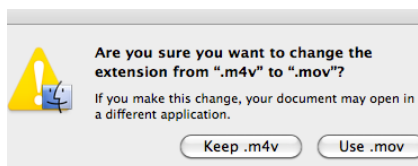
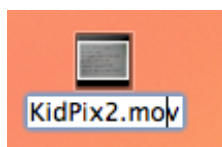
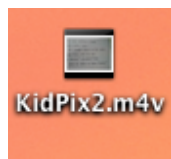
To view it, click on the link, this pops up.

You can choose to open it in QuickTime or save it. If you save it, it will open in I-Tunes. If it does not open, drag it into QuickTime Player on the dock or in the applications folder.



Another alternative would be to change the .m4v extension to .mov  
It will ask whether you if you are sure you want to change it, click Use .mov
