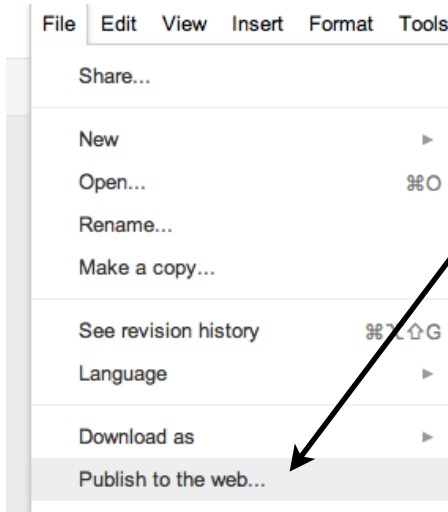


# Embedding a Google Document

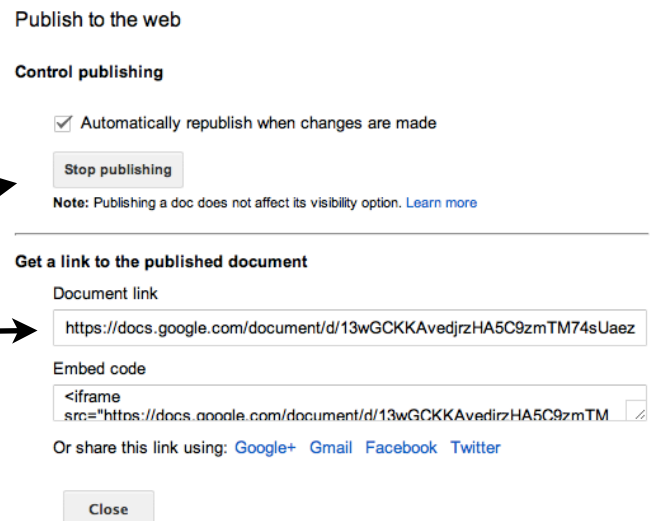
1. In your Google Doc, click on Share and then change to Public on the web



2. Use the File menu and click on Publish to the web.

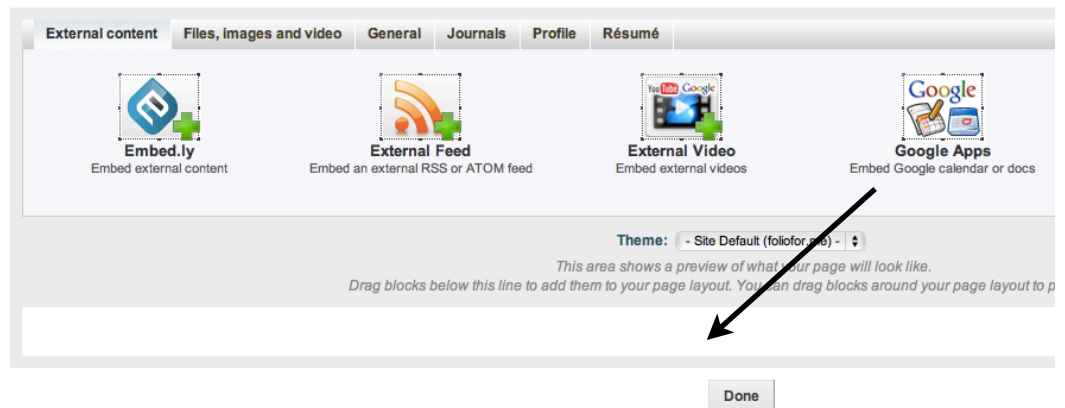


3. Click on Start Publishing.



Then copy the Document Link URL and Close

4. Drag the Google Apps content block down onto the page.



5. Give the content block a title

6. Paste the Publish to the web URL copied in step 3

7. Adjust size if desired

Click Save
