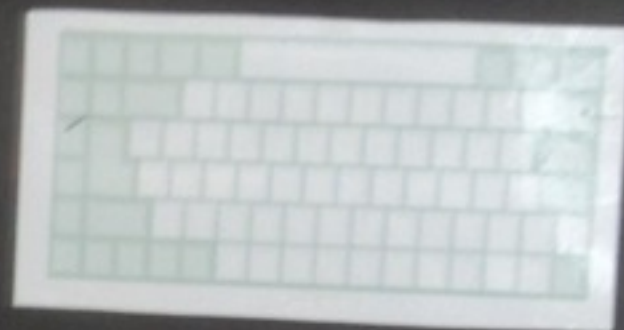

Most grid cells remain consistent throughout the year, some may change depending on learning space needs.

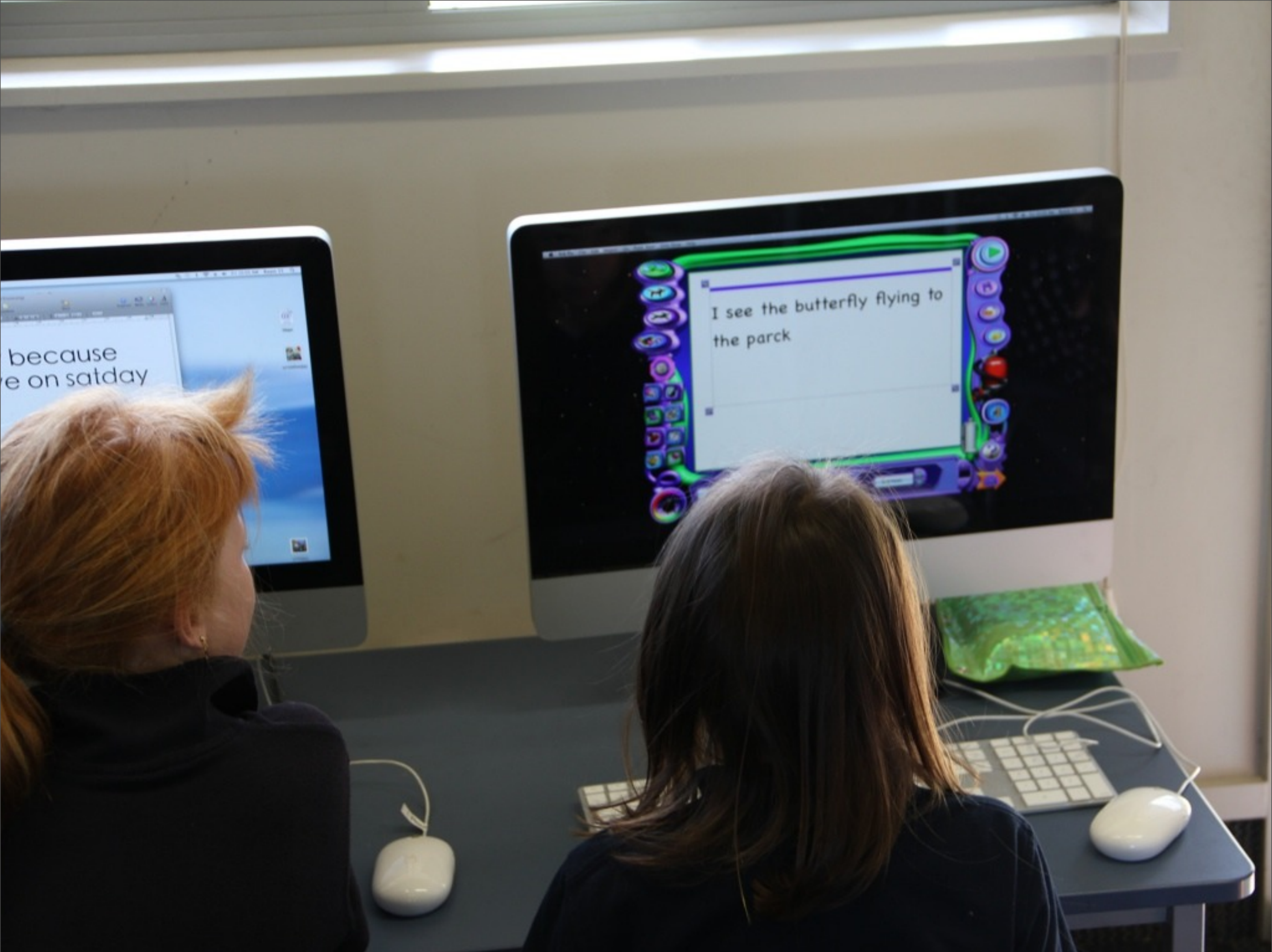












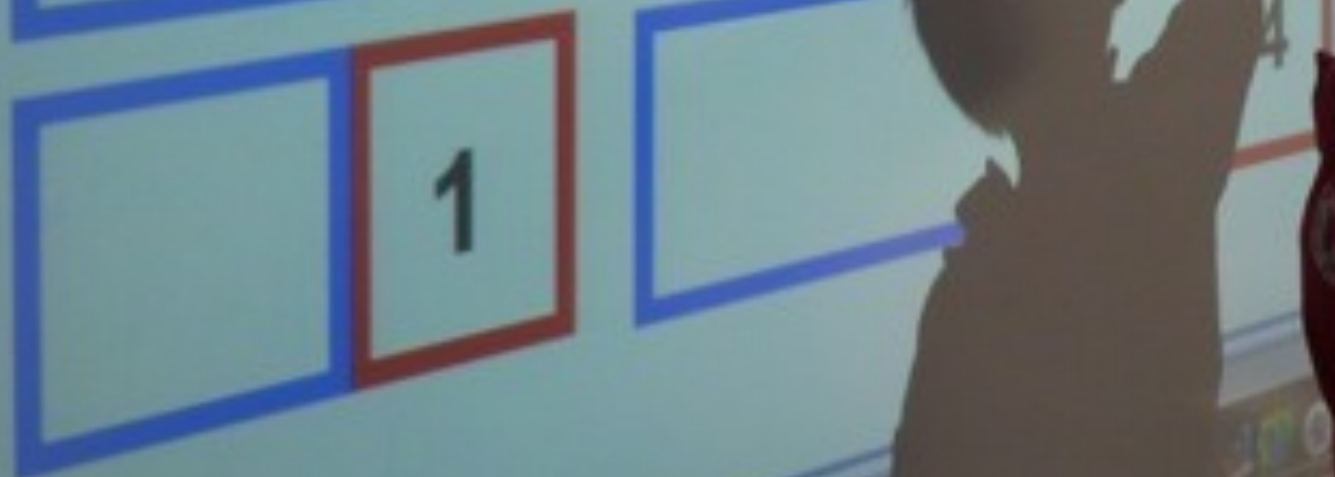
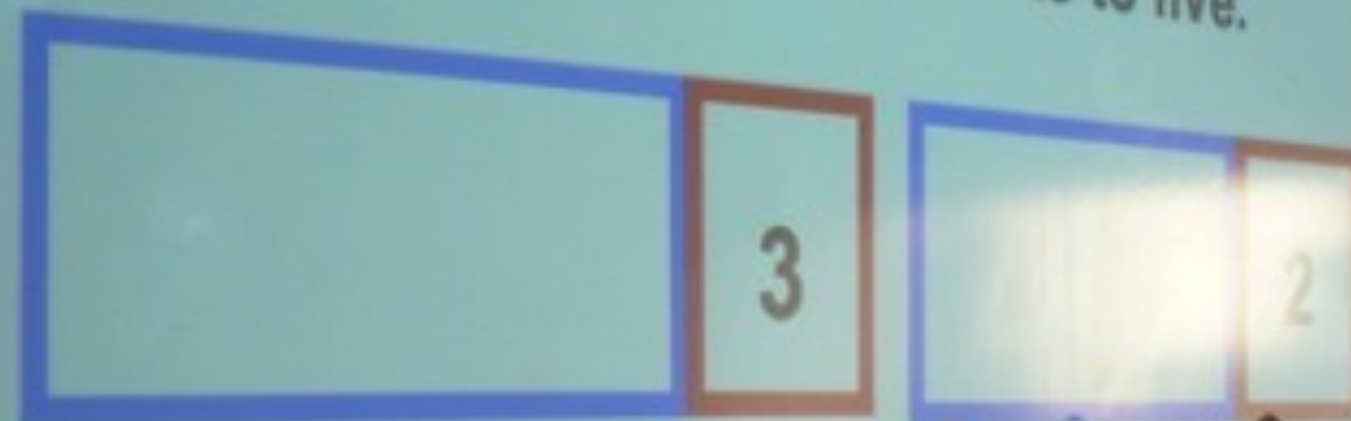
