

**Reservoir High School Music Boosters  
Executive Board Meeting  
December 10, 2007**

**Call to Order**

President Wes Alexander called the meeting to order at 7:35.

**Minutes of the 11/12/07 Executive Board meeting**

Minutes of the 11/12/07 Executive Board meeting were distributed. The minutes were approved as written.

**Treasurer's Report**

- Anne Lee reviewed the Profit and Loss Budget Performance spreadsheet.
- Expenses will be slightly under budget for marching band and Madrigals
- The marching band banquet is projected to have a small profit (target was cost-neutral)
- We are likely to be under budget for ads and donations
- All-state concessions made \$330
- We still need to collect about a third of the music participation fees

**Hot Business**

- Winter concerts:
  - Choir and orchestra will donate food, packaged in \$0.50 quantities. Need another parent to help with concession stand on December 19.
- Sub Sale
  - The chairs brought samples to show how they will be packaged and allow taste testing. The goal this year is to establish the subs as a high quality product. The prices will be \$6.50/sub, \$25/party pack (4 subs and bag of chips), with a student profit estimated at \$1/sub, \$5.00/party pack.

**On the Horizon:**

- Pops Concert:
  - The Pops Concert will be January 26, 2008. Cheryl Ruffa will chair, but she would like a co-chair. They are getting started on planning, and will have more information to report out at the next Music Booster meetings.
- Spiritwear will be sold at concerts.
- Fruit pickup: Delivery will be by 10:00 Saturday, and pickup will be 12-2.
- Spring Trip:
  - 155 students have signed up for spring trip, and the next payment is due January 7. People who would like to chaperone should contact Wes or one of the directors.
- The 5K Race will be held May 10 (Saturday of Mother's Day weekend). Greg Schuler will chair again, and he expects that it will raise more this year than last. Greg would like to reduce entry fees, based on last year's data. 228 registered runners last year.
- Art Auction
  - Tickets go on sale at the winter concerts. They will need volunteers for the auction, but Rob Dice doesn't have the sign-up form yet.

**Staff comments**

- Greg Knauf: The winter concerts are this week and next, and the music is coming together nicely. Thanks to people for coming to the musical in November.

**Open Discussion**

- John Lee – received discount coupon booklet from Kidstuff, which specializes in band organization. The booklets sell for \$25, and we would get \$12.50 profit. We would only have to pay for the ones we sell. If we did this as a fundraiser, it would be next year – they release books in August.
- Rob Dice – merchants would like customers to let them know when they visit because of an ad in the concert program
- Brenda sent the URL for Bonnie's Marching Band pictures to the yearbook coordinator. The yearbook coordinator is sending a professional photographer to take pictures of the musical groups.
