Call to Order

President Wes Alexander called the meeting to order at 7:30.

Minutes of the 12/10/07 Executive Board meeting

Minutes of the 12/10/07 Executive Board meeting were distributed. The anticipated profits for the sub sale were corrected, and then the minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report

Anne Lee reviewed the Profit and Loss Budget Performance spreadsheet.

The Boosters made \$513 by selling off old spiritwear at discount prices

Dave Sherry noted that we've spent about 60% of budget, but have only brought in 25% of income. Anne Lee noted that our biggest fundraisers are still to come. This affects cash flow, but we're doing OK.

Spring trip costs are based on an assumption of 150 students, 20 pairs of which are siblings. The costs are projected to be \$500 for full-paying students and \$400 for siblings. All expenses must be paid 4-6 weeks in advance (unlike last year, when we paid afterward). Therefore, it is essential for people to pay on time this year!

- Planning is going well, and they will be getting donations from several organizations

Sub Sales

- Orders are due January 24
- Kama Hoe has found 3 industrial grade meat slicers that we can borrow to slice roast beef and provolone Saturday morning. We need 15 adults Friday evening (Feb. 1) at 7:00 to set up, and adults Saturday morning (Feb. 2) at 7:00 a.m. Students are to arrive at 7:30 on Saturday. We must be out of cafeteria by noon
