6:45 am	Band report time in casual clothes with marching shoes. Attendance taken. Cases, equipment, and instruments to truck and load truck.
7:00	On practice field, stretch and body warm up/wake up, Basics & Runs without equipment
7:40	End Rehearsal
7:50	Load and Board Buses.
8:00	Depart for Naval-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium (Naval Academy)
8:45	Arrive Naval-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium (Naval Academy). Change into uniform, get instrument from truck, use bathroom, etc.
9:10	March to Warm-Up Area
9:15	Warm-Up
10:10	Leave warm-up area and march to stadium gate
10:27	Gate time – start breathing exercises staying focused
10:42	PERFORMANCE!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
10:57 pm	March out of stadium. Picture time then march to truck, change clothes in bus, wear warm clothes that is RHS Spirit wear – Orange and/or Navy Blue (GO RESERVOIR!!!!!!).
11:40	Depart Naval-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium to head to Main Street Annapolis for lunch and free time. They have a food court, Subway, and several restaurants (<i>BRING MONEY</i>). Trio Rule in effect!!!!
1:15	Return to busses, take attendance and head back to Naval-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium and sit in stands watching remaining bands. Reservoir ALWAYS sits together (sit in section 3 ; together we are one!!!!!!)!!!!!!!!!! REMINDER , be on your best audience behavior regardless of other bands behavior.
3:30	Awards Presentation. Following completion of Awards, move to bus. Take attendance
4:15	Depart Naval-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium (Naval Academy).
5:00	Arrive Reservoir High School. <i>EVERYONE</i> unloads the truck, clean up buses and band room. No one leaves until all jobs are finished
5:30	GO HOME and be proud of what you have accomplished today!!!!!!!

- Bagged lunch & money for dinner food via Concessions at Show
