Call to Order

Minutes of the 04/9/07 Executive Board meeting

Minutes of the 04/9/07 Executive Board meeting were distributed. The minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report

Anne Lee reviewed the Profit & Loss Budget Performance sheet.

Income:

- Numbers are not all in for 5K race but looks to be around \$4700
- Car wash earned \$817
- Art Auction check received for \$5823.52
- Spring Concert ticket sales netted \$2368 and concessions earned \$345

Expenses:

- Winter Guard expenses are in and under budget
- Indoor Drumline still has a cargo truck payment to submit
- Clinicians were paid \$900
- Paid out \$2500 for awards so far

Other financial Notes:

- We currently have \$10,000 more assets at the end of the year than we started with at the beginning. Although not all bills have been paid yet, we anticipate a significant surplus.
- We should be thinking of what to do with the \$48,000 in assets we have to make it work for us better – CD? Money market? Need ideas.

Hot Business

- **Election** – no new candidates emerged so this year's officers were re-elected.
- **Scholarship Committee** – deliberations are over; all 6 submissions were awarded scholarships for a total of \$1450.
- **Awards Banquet** – there are about 250 tickets sold so far; volunteers have been solicited by Donna Fenicle; Sherrie still needs students to help.
- **Musical Madness 5K Race** – there were 192 registered for 5K, 12 for the 1K; Greg Schuler has received many positive reviews from the runners about how good the course was, the added goodie of the music performances, and the good food. He is still doing the accounting after spending the rest of the weekend writing the press report. We plan on doing this again next year on the same weekend,

- **Spring Concerts:** All three Directors thanked everyone for all the support and the fine music.
- Greg Knauf noted that fundraisers for the summer need to be submitted by June 1
- John Rhoad thanked the music department for 4 great years.
