

**Westminster High School Marching Band Show Itinerary**  
**Saturday, September 12, 2009**

8:00 am	Drumline Rehearsal (Colorguard rehearsal and report time –TBA)
9:15	Band report time in casual clothes with marching shoes. Attendance taken
9:30	On stadium field, stretch and body warm up/wake up!!!
9:45	Music warm up
10:00	Basics
10:30	Field Rehearsal (cleaning music and drill)
1:15 pm	Practice Entering, Exiting Field & Run Throughs
1:50	End Rehearsal – Cases, equipment, uniforms, shakos, and instruments to truck and load truck. Eat lunch brought from home. No student is permitted to leave campus.
2:45	Load and Board Buses
3:00	Depart for Westminster High School
4:00	Arrive Westminster High School. Change into uniform, get instrument from truck, use bathroom, etc.
4:40	March to Warm-Up Area
4:45	Warm-Up
6:05	Leave warm-up area and march to stadium gate
6:18	Gate time – start breathing exercises staying focused
6:30	<b>PERFORMANCE!!!!!!!!!!!!!!</b>
6:45	March out of stadium to truck, change clothes in bus, wear <b>warm</b> clothes that is RHS Spirit wear – Orange and/or Navy Blue (GO RESERVOIR!!!!!!). Eat dinner via Concessions ( <b>BRING MONEY</b> ) and sit in visitor stands (non-press box side) watching remaining bands. Reservoir ALWAYS sits together (together we are one!!!!!!)!!!!!!!!!! <b>REMINDER</b> , be on your best audience behavior regardless of other bands behavior.
7:45	Awards Presentation. Following completion of Awards, move to bus. Take attendance
8:30	Depart Westminster High School
9:30	Arrive Reservoir High School. <b>EVERYONE</b> unloads the truck, clean up buses and band room. No one leaves until all jobs are finished
9:45	GO HOME and be proud of what you have accomplished today!!!!!!
