Call to Order

Minutes of the 2/11/08 Executive Board meeting

Minutes of the 2/11/08 Executive Board meeting were distributed.

Treasurer's Report

- Anne Lee reviewed the Profit and Loss Budget Performance spreadsheet.
- Sponsor-related fundraising came in \$1000 over budget.
- Art Auction income is projected to be \$3300; attendance and sales were down this year.
- There are only 20 more participation fees to be collected.
- Winter guard has incurred some expenses, and will need buses for two trips, but it is likely to come in under budget.
- Indoor drumline has dissolved this year. We paid \$75 in registration fees before it dissolved, but it incurred no other costs.
- Half of the hotel and tickets have already been paid for spring trip. More bills are due later this month. The cost of the trip is projected to be \$515 per student.
- Anne will be filing the annual property tax form (which is required even though we have no property).

Hot Business

- Dinner Raffle
 - We have collected about \$1000 so far; sales are on-going
- Nominating Committee
 - John Lee has posted the request for nominations and sent out an email. He has a list of parents who have expressed interest through the directors, and he would like to reach out to others as well.
 - Anne Lee has suggested splitting student account responsibilities off from the treasurer's job.
 - The nominating committee is also looking for committee chairs.
- Car Washes
 - Matt is hoping to move the May 10 car wash to May 3; he will check with school calendar to be sure no other organization already has a car wash planned.

On the Horizon

- Spring Trip
 - The trip schedule has been posted on the web site, and it will be updated with details once Fiesta-val provides the performance information. The groups will perform at two different venues (choral and instrumental). Brian Donnelly is going to Virginia Beach at the beginning of April to check out the locations.
- 5K Race

- Greg Schuler reported that 31 runners are now registered and sponsors are still signing up. He was a guest speaker at the Maple Lawn business association meeting last week. Packet pickup for the runners will be on May 8 at Feet First and May 9 at Daily Grind.

 - Sherry Kirkpatrick and Chris Mitchell are considering different caterers and looking for additional ideas
- Scholarship Committee
 - Susannah Schiller will chair; Sally Kelly and Donna Fenicle will also serve on committee
