8:00 am	Drumline & Colorguard report time
8:15	Drumline & Colorguard Rehearsal
10:45	Band report time in casual clothes with marching shoes. Attendance taken
11:00	On field (we'll tell you which field on Saturday), stretch and body warm up/wake up!!!
11:15	Basics. Colorguard and Drumline go to lunch.
11:50	Music warm up
12:00 pm	Field Rehearsal (cleaning music and drill)
2:50	Practice Entering, Exiting Field & Runs
3:10	End Rehearsal – Cases, equipment, and instruments to truck and load truck, eat early dinner brought from home or pizza purchased through Music Boosters. No student is permitted to leave campus. Uniforms and shakos to bus.
4:15	Load and Board Buses
4:30	Depart for Northwest High School
5:30	Arrive Northwest High School. Change into uniform, get instrument from truck, use bathroom, etc.
