### Saturday, October 16, 2010

8:45 am	Drumline & Colorguard report time
9:00	Drumline & Colorguard rehearsal.
11:45	Band report time in casual clothes with marching shoes. Attendance taken
12:00 pm	On field (we'll let you know where), stretch and body warm up/wake up!!!
12:15	Music warm up. Drumline and Guard goes to lunch.
12:30	Basics
1:00	Field Rehearsal (cleaning music and drill) drumline and guard included
4:00	Practice Entering, Exiting Field & Run Throughs
4:20	End Rehearsal – Cases, equipment, uniforms, shakos, and instruments to truck and load truck. <b>Eat bagged dinner brought from home or pizza purchased through Music Boosters.</b> Students are not permitted to leave campus.
5:20	Load and Board Buses
5:30	Depart for Towson University
6:15	Arrive Towson University. Change into uniform, get instrument from truck, use bathroom, etc.
6:55	March to Warm-Up Area
7:00	Warm-Up
8:25	Leave warm-up area and march to stadium gate
8:35	Gate time – start breathing exercises staying focused
8:49	<b>PERFORMANCE!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!</b>
9:02	March out of stadium to truck, change clothes in bus, wear <b>warm</b> clothes that is RHS Spirit wear – Orange and/or Navy Blue (GO RESERVOIR!!!!!!). Eat dinner via Concessions ( <b>BRING MONEY</b> ) and sit in visitor stands (non-press box side) watching remaining bands.
