8:00 am	Drumline & Colorguard Rehearsal
10:50	Band report time in casual clothes. Attendance taken
11:00	On grass field (we'll let you know where), stretch and body warm up/wake up!!!
11:15	Music warm up. Drumline and Colorguard go to lunch.
11:30	Basics
12:00pm	Full Marching Band Field Rehearsal (cleaning music and drill)
3:10	Practice Entering, Exiting Field & Run Throughs
3:30	End Rehearsal – Cases, equipment, uniforms, shakos, and instruments to truck and load truck. Eat lunch brought from home or pizza purchased from Music Boosters. No student is permitted to leave campus.
4:30	Load and Board Buses
4:45	Depart for Westminster High School
5:30	Arrive Westminster High School. Change into uniform, get instrument from truck, use bathroom, etc.
6:10	March to Warm-Up Area
6:15	Warm-Up
7:50	Leave warm-up area and march to stadium gate
8:00	Gate time – start breathing exercises staying focused
8:15	PERFORMANCE!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
8:30	March out of stadium to truck, change clothes in bus, wear warm clothes that is RHS Spirit wear – Orange and/or Navy Blue (GO RESERVOIR!!!!!!).
