

Introduction to the Class Website

Welcome to the World History Class Online! The purpose of this page is to assist you on how to use the site.

1. The home page of the site includes all the Progress Charts you will need to complete the class. You will also find the "Journal Contents," which are the names of each of your individual journals that you will complete in a 100-page composition book.
2. The Navigation drop-down menu on the right hand side of the page has each of the units split up by unit.
3. Within each unit page you will see a progress chart and then a list of handouts needed to complete the progress chart.
4. Simply print the progress chart and the handouts you need for each unit.
5. Follow the progress chart step-by-step.

How should my Composition book look?

1. It starts with your Journal Contents. Simply cut and tape these as the first two pages of your journal.
2. The next page of your journal you should tape the list of standards that you are covering for that unit. These are easily found at the beginning of the progress chart.
3. Then cut and tape your progress chart on both the right and left hand sides of the next page.
- 4. You are now ready to begin!**
5. Follow each step of the progress chart. The Chart will indicate what you put on the left and the right side of your journal.
6. If no side is specified in your instructions – then you always use the right side first.
7. Make sure each journal is numbered correctly in the upper right hand corner of your composition book.
8. This journal number should match the number in your "Journal Contents" section.

Important!!

- 1. The Essential Question, if used, should be listed on the left hand side of the Journal at the top.**
- 2. You don't have to answer the Essential Question....because you already did.....in your completed activity.**
- 3. Once you have completed the activity ask yourself the Essential Question! Can you answer it? You should be able to!**
