

PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT

This is a hunt inside your classroom. The goal is to find all the ingredients to Sharon's Secret Recipe for Freckle Juice (photos of the ingredients).

Start hunt after page 28 before Andrew opens the recipe to read it. Have this note folded inside your book along with the cut out clues below. Open the note as if it is the recipe and then read to class. Then give a student Clue #1. Have the class predict what ingredient they will be looking for before they search for it. (we searched in small groups) As you find ingredients add them to the blank ingredients paper until you find them all. ***Alternate idea: Divide class into 4 groups and give each group 2 clues. They will all read and search at once for the ingredients.

Have a student read Clue # 1

After they find grape juice photo have a student read Clue #2.

After they find vinegar picture have a student read Clue # 3.

After they find ketchup & mustard photo have a student read Clue #4.

After they find onion photo have a student read Clue #5.

After they find salt & pepper photo have a student read Clue #6.

After they find olive oil photo have a student read Clue #7.

After they find mayonnaise photo have a student read Clue #8.

Prepare ahead of time: Cut apart photos on last page and hide them, cut apart clues to be read by students in class. Cut out letter fold and put in book along with all the clues.

*Hide small grape juice photo behind/beside the number nine on calendar.

*Hide small photo of vinegar under teacher's desk.

*Hide small mustard and ketchup photos under chair where you read to students.

*Hide onion photo under kleenex box in the room.

*Hide salt and pepper by the lunch menu.

*Hide olive oil photo in an Author book in your classroom library.

*Hide mayonnaise under classroom lamp.

*Hide lemon on back of classroom door.

Clue #1

See if you can guess the first ingredient Andrew needs to give him lots of freckles. It is a juice made from a fruit. The fruit grows on a vine and is hidden on the calendar beside a number that rhymes with line.

Clue # 2

This ingredient smells kind of gross. It is often used in Easter Egg dye. In the book Owen by Kevin Henkes Owen's parents used this to make his blanket smell. You can find it under the teacher's desk. Be sure to look well.

Clue # 3

You might like these toppings with your hotdog on a bun. (hint: there is not just one, but two.) Look in the classroom where your teacher sits to read to you.

Clue #4

This ingredient might give you many tears or make you cry. You can find it at the place where you blow your nose or wipe your tears dry.

Clue #5

This ingredient is white and black and comes in 2 containers. You might sprinkle these things on your food so it tastes good to you. You can find the answer by the lunch menu.

Clue # 6

This ingredient is a yellowish liquid and it comes inside a tall bottle. It's used for many things in the kitchen that your mom might cook. You can find this information you need in our classroom library inside a Marc Brown, Arthur book.

Alternate to clue 6 to use a different class library book.

Clue # 6

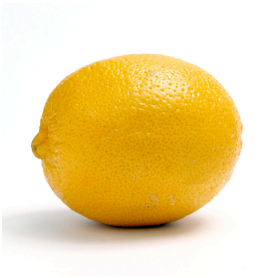
