This is in reference to your appeal/complaint petition dated 17.05.2012. I am directed to convey that the Hindustan Times Media Limited is not covered under the definition of “Public Authority” as mentioned in Sec. 2 (h) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 quoted herein under:

**Sec. 2 (h) of the RTI Act, 2005.**

*"Public Authority" Means any Authority or body or institution of self-government established or constituted,-*

- (a) By or under the Constitution;*
- (b) By any other law made by parliament;*
- (c) By any other law made by state legislature;*
- (d) By notification issued or made by the appropriate*

*Government, and includes any, -*

- (i) Body owned, controlled or substantially financed;*
- (ii) Non - Government Organization substantially financed,*  
*directly or indirectly by funds provided by the appropriate*  
*Government;*

3. In view of the above quoted provisions of Section 2(h) of RTI Act, 2005, your application, is being filed, since Hindustan Times Media Limited, is not a “Public Authority” and the case is being treated as closed.
