2 02-03-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State. This writ application has been filed by the petitioner who has asked for certain information with respect to Temporary Permit No. 2009-10 of Vehicle No. BR9A-9275 Jeep Taxi and Permit No. 2510/2008-09 of Vehicle No. BR9B-9275 Tanker. The Transport Secretary has already directed that the information should be given to the petitioner vide Memo No. 672, Patna dated 8.7.2011. However, the information has not been supplied although a time period of one week was fixed. The respondents are directed to furnish the information as per the provisions of Right to Information Act and, if, such information is not

furnished, to take action against the erring officer. This writ application is disposed of with a direction to the concerned authority to ensure that the petitioner is given information within the shortest possible time and to take action against the erring authority, if he has withheld the information without reasonable cause. The petitioner is at liberty to bring this order to the notice of the concerned authority. (Sheema Ali Khan, J.)
