J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is challenging Ext.P2 order passed by the State Information Commission holding that the Kerala State Small Industries Association, a society registered under the Travancore Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Act, is a public authority as defined in the Right to Information

Act.

The petitioner claims to be a member of the said society. I am of opinion that even if the petitioner is a member of the society, the petitioner has no locus standi to file this writ petition since the person aggrieved if at all is the society itself. In the above circumstances, this writ petition is dismissed as not maintainable at the instance of the petitioner.
