- How is the problem in this chapter solved?



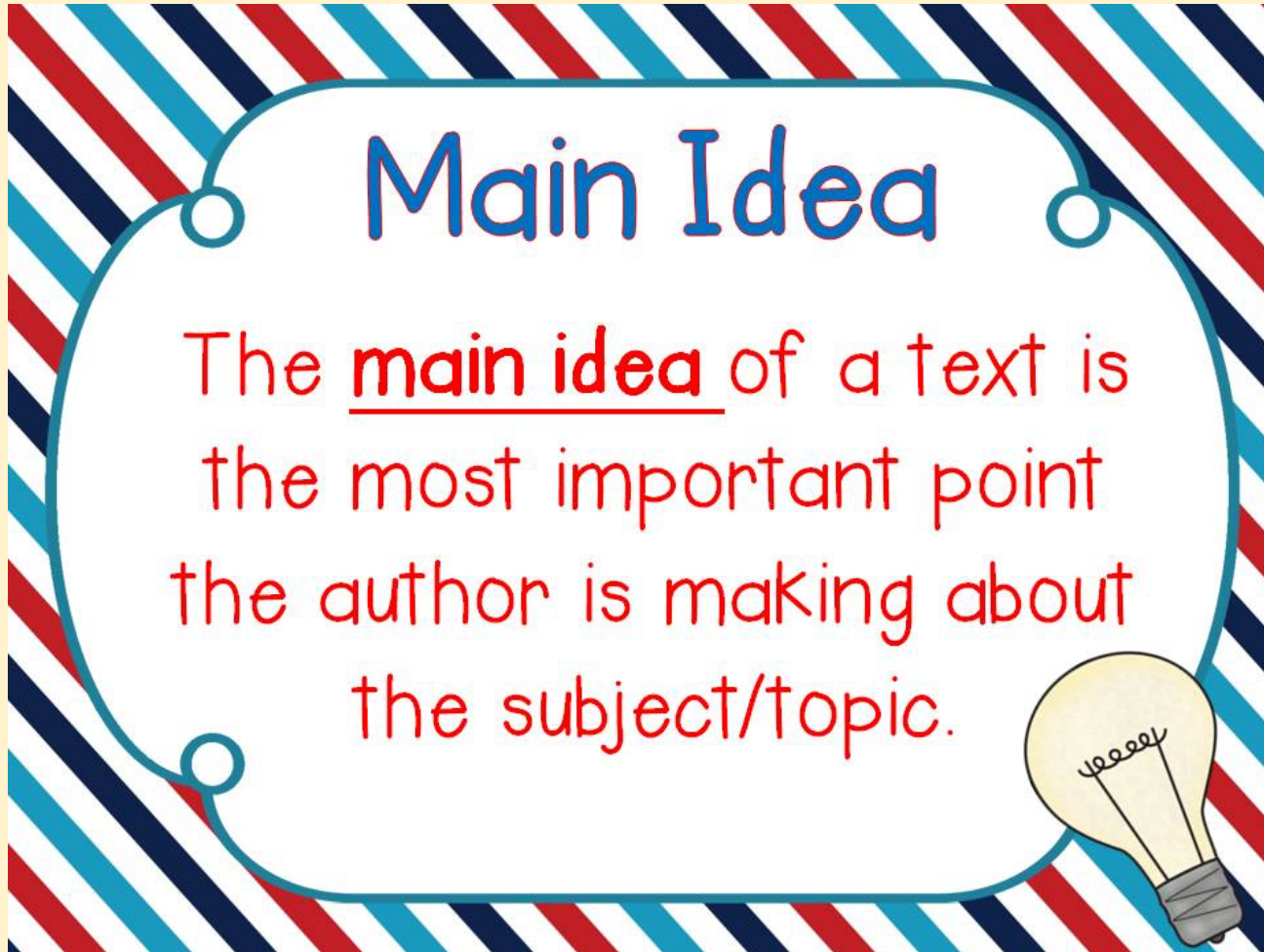
