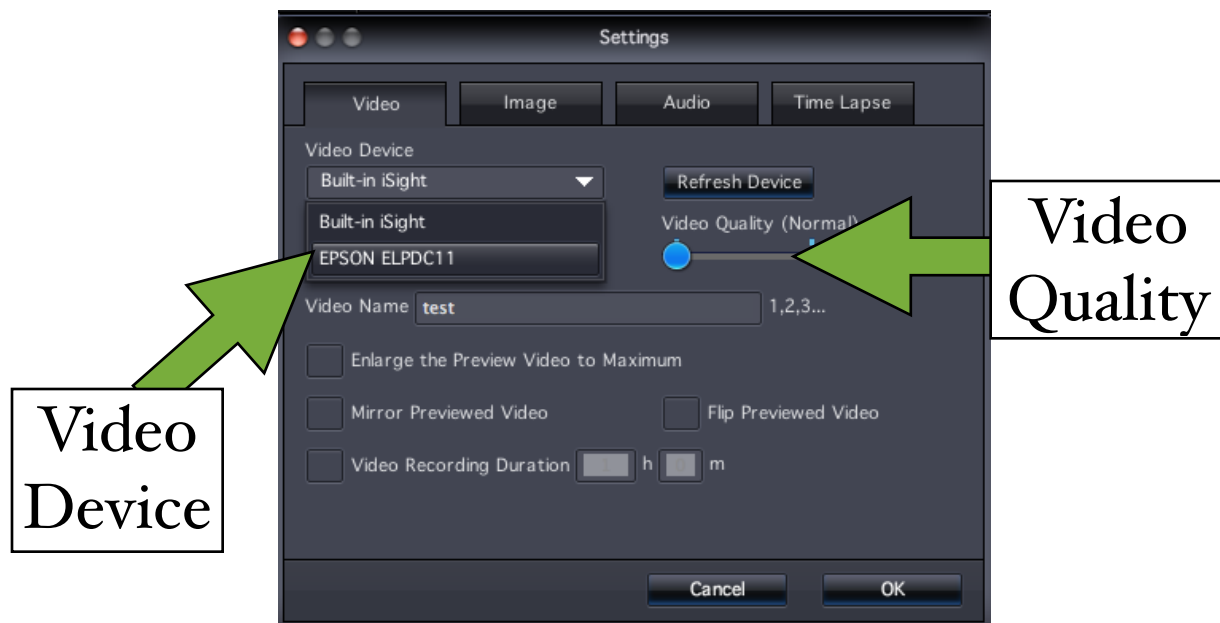


Creating a Video using your Document Camera

1. Connect your computer to the document camera using the white USB cable, and turn the document camera on.
2. Open the ArcSoft Application Software on your computer (use Spotlight to find it quickly). The window below will open.



3. Go to the Settings button and set the Video Device to EPSON ELPDC11. Set the Video Quality slider to Normal (the lowest it will go).



4. If you are using a headset to record, click on the Audio tab and select the appropriate headset. Or, if you want to use the microphone on the Document Camera, select the EPSON ELPDC11 again. Click OK.



5. When you are ready to record, click on the RECORD button on the bottom of the ArcSoft window.



6. While you are recording, the RECORD button will turn into a pause button. When you are finished recording, click that button to stop.
7. Your video will appear in the left-hand side of the ArcSoft window. It will also be saved in a folder named Document Camera Media, which will by default be in your Documents folder.
8. Depending on how long your video is, it will be very large and will need to be compressed to a smaller size. There are two ways to do this:
- Open the file in QuickTime Player and then Share it to iTunes, making it as small as necessary.
 - Import the file directly into iMovie. This is your best option if you'd like to make any editing changes, add titles, transitions, etc. When you're finished with any edits, Share it to iTunes, and make it as small as possible.
9. You can now post your video online (YouTube, sophis, screencast, wiki) or upload it to Edmodo (maximum upload is 100MB).
