- Rocks are made from a combination of minerals.
- Depending how they form, determines what type they are.

- 3 types

Igneous - form from lava (on surface) or magma (underground) cooling and solidifying.

Sedimentary - form from pieces of rock being cemented together
- or form from a chemical precipitate/solid when something changes the chemistry of the solution

Metamorphic - heat or pressure change a pre-existing rock

Igneous Rocks

- Extrusive (volcanic) rocks
- cool quickly
→ small or no crystals
 - small → rhyolite, basalt
 - no → obsidian, pumice
