

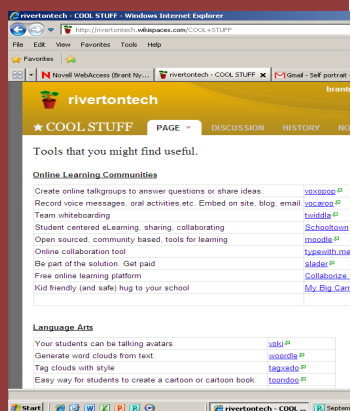

This portion of the wiki is a collection of useful educational tools spanning all content areas.



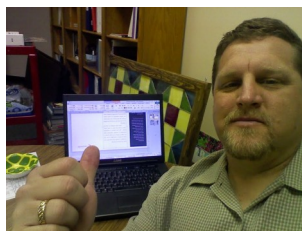
It is continually updated, as new tools become available. There is even a discussion thread for you to add your ideas.

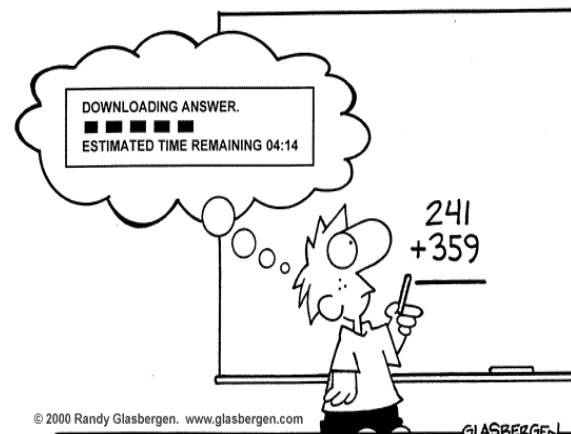
If there are any educational tech tools you are having trouble with, please call 4212 and let Brant know. If he can't fix it, he'll find someone who can.
