

Music

Incorporating your target language music is a fun way to get students excited about taking a foreign language, especially if the teacher incorporates all types of music. Use the songs to show examples of grammar principles, vocabulary, and to teach culture. Have the students sing the songs if possible.

Students love to go to youtube to hear and view the songs that you present in class. They will talk about it with their friends and since they do not get to listen to music in other classes, listening to music is a good recruiting tool.

Here are some German examples of songs you can use to teach different Grammar principles. Only play a verse or chorus of the song to show the example.
